Friday June 15th 1860

Coms in with light
breezes from the Southward and squally
Course S.W. middle and latter part wind
from the S.W. and squally plenty of
thunder and lightning Course S.W. by W
Lat 28.34 N
Long 63.49 W

Saturday June 16th

Commences with strong
breezes from the S.W. and cloudy
ships Course S.W. by W at sunset short
red sail middle and latter part Pleasant
Lat 29.15 N
Long 65.50 W

Sunday June 17th

Coms in with light from
the S.W. and squally plenty of thunder
lightning & rain ships Course S.W. by W
and a ship steering S.E. middle and latter
weather the same saw a Bark steering
S
Lat 31.32 N
Long 67.44 W

Monday June 18th

Commences with strong
breezes from the N.W. and squally plenty
lightning ships Course N.W. middle part
the same latter part pleasant wind from
the N.W. three sails in sight
Lat 32.43 N
Long 68.16 W

Bark Lactitia Homeward Bound

Tuesday June 20th 1860

Coms in with moderate
breezes from the N.W. and pleasant ship
heading S.E. one Brig in sight middle
and latter part light winds from the S.W.
ship heading N by S Lat 33.46 N
Long 68.29 W

Wednesday June 20th

Commences with light airs
and calms middle part fine breezes
from the S.W. latter part strong and rain
saw several sails ships Course S.W.
by S Lat 35.11
Long 69.47

Thursday June 21st

Coms in with light
from the S.W. and pleasant Course
S.W. middle part gale from the S.E. and
heavy squalls plenty of rain latter
middle and latter part the same
Lat 37.05 N
Long 69.50 W

Wednesday June 22nd

Coms in with light from
the S.E. and pleasant ship heading N.W. by W
middle part squally and gale from the S.E.
latter part fresh breezes and sail stored
N.W. by S one Bark in sight Lat 38.32
Long 70.42
