

Remarks on Board the Lactia

Friday June 23rd 1860

Came in with strong
breezes with and rugged ship heading
SSE one bark in sight - middle part
strong breezes from the SSE ships head-
ing N by W latter part moderate

Lat 40° 27' N

Sunday

Long 71° 57' W

Saturday June 24th

Came in with light
wind from the SSE ship heading SSE
at 3 P.M. took a pilot - at 5 P.M. made
the Land East End of Long island
bearing N by W dist 20 miles thick snow
lay in either middle and latter part light
winds from the SSE employed at Beating

Sunday June 25th

Came in with light winds
from the SSE at 7 P.M. Block island
bearing W by N Dist 12 miles
