

Remarks on Board Bark

Friday ~~Thursday~~ Sept 2nd 1864

Came in with strong winds from the Southward and pleasant ship heading E by S seven day from New Bedford in Lat^t 38.32 N Long 57.30 W had the wind from South to West and squally weather in leaving him mid S and latter part pleasant ship heading E by S

Saturday 3rd

Came in with strong breezes from the N W and pleasant ship heading E by S middle and latter part the same saw three sails speak the Bark German of Provincetown eighteen months out with two hundred lbs sperm oil Board him

Came in with strong winds from the N W and squally ship heading E by S sail in sight steering E by S middle and latter part weather the same

Came in with strong wind from the N W and pleasant ship heading E by S saw a Brig heading N W middle and latter part weather the same

Tuesday Sept 6th 1864

Came in with moderate winds from the S W and pleasant ship course E by S saw pumps & Porpoise this day at sunset shortened sail left to the wind heading South middle part the same latter part steering E Lat^t 35.42 N

Thursday 7th Came in with moderate wind from the N W and pleasant ship course E by S pick at a wh. Gally for in the water about four miles middle and latter part weather the same

Friday 8th Came in with moderate winds from the Westward & pleasant ship course E by S middle and latter part weather the same

Saturday 9th Came in with moderate breezes from the Westward & pleasant saw a ship steering E by S middle and latter part weather the same

Sunday 10th Came in with light winds from the S W & pleasant saw several ships this day bound E by S middle & latter part light airs and calms

Monday 11th Came in with light airs and calms five sails in sight middle and latter part weather the same
