Friday Nov 25th 1864

Cms in with moderate gale from the S.W. one sail in sight middle and latter part moderate and pleasant Lat 33.11

Long 47.53

Saturday 26th Cms in with moderate winds from the W.S.W. pleasant sun three sails this day middle and latter part light wind from the Eastward Lat 33.36

Long 47.06

Sunday 27th Cms in with strong breezes from the S.E. and pleasant sun a Bark steering W.S.W. middle and latter part sunny weather Lat 33.26

Long 47.13

Monday 28th Cms in with strong breezes from the Southward cloudy weather sun a Bark steering W at 7 P.M. wind shifted to the Southward middle and latter part gale from the South Lat 33.11

Long 47.11

Tuesday 29th Cms in with a moderate gale from the South middle and latter part weather the same Lat 33.06

Long 47.06

Wednesday 30th Cms in with fresh breezes from the Southward and squalls sun two sails middle and latter part weather the same Lat 33.07

Long 48.26

Thursday Dec 1st Cms in with strong breezes and squalls from S.E. middle and latter part moderate at 10 A.M. seven whals bred the boats in pursuit Lat 33.16

Long 48.46

Lactine Cruising

Friday Dec 2nd 1864

Cms in with light wind from S.E. and fog signals boats off in pursuit of whals had no success middle and latter part weather the same at 6 A.M. seven whals at 7 bred the Boats in pursuit thus ends Lat 33.08

Long 48.30

Saturday 3rd Cms in with light winds from the S.W. and pleasant boats off in pursuit of whals at 3 P.M. Ben boat struck and got stove lumbered boat struck and killed the whale took to the ship at 6 P.M. middle and latter part moderate employed at cutting Lat 32.57

Sunday 4th Cms in with strong winds from S.E. and cloudy weather employed at cutting lost the case by the Chain porting middle and latter part moderate gale from the S.E. dark cloudy weather

Monday 5th Cms in with moderate from the S.E. sun rain and rigged employed at cutting up butter middle part the same latter part moderate and pleasant wind from S.W. at 5 am started the work sun two sails Lat 33.35 Long 47.51

Tuesday 6th Cms in with light winds from the S.W. and pleasant employed at cutting middle and latter part the same Lat 32.58
