Monday January 1st 1865

Came in with strong breeze from the N.W. with a bad sea ship heading S by E middle and latter part moderate breeze from the S.E. ship heading S.W.

Tuesday 2nd Came in with strong winds from the S.E. and pleasant ship heading S.W. saw several finbacks saw kelp seen and got ground in 80 fathoms Barometer stands on 29-8-10 middle and latter part squally

Wednesday 3rd Came in with light winds from S.E. and pleasant sound and got ground in sixty five fathoms Barometer stands on 30 and 10 middle part calm latter part light winds from the S.W. & pleasant

Thursday 4th Came in with a fine breeze from the S.W. and pleasant ship's course S by W sound and got ground in 70 fathoms Barometer stands on 30.8-1-10 middle part light winds from the S.W. latter part wind from the S.W. and

Friday 5th Came in with light winds from S.E. and smoky weather ship's course South rounded and got ground in 72 fathoms saw narwhals and much kelp Barometer stands on 29-2-10 middle and latter part weather the same

Came in with light winds from the S.W. and pleasant ship heading South middle and latter part weather the same

Saturday 7th Came in with light winds from the S.W. and foggy ship heading South rounded and got ground in 10 fathoms Barometer stands on 29-4-10 middle and latter part strong breeze from S.E. and thick fog

Sunday 8th Came in with strong wind from the S.W. and foggy at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the S.W. and cleared off ships course S.E. & S.W. saw many narwhals and much kelp Barometer stands on 29-5-10 middle part the same latter part strong S.E.

Monday 10th Came in with moderate wind from the S.W. and pleasant ship's course S.W. saw a bark steering E.S.E. middle part moderate latter part fresh gale and rain from the S.E. saw a Bark

Tuesday 11th Came in with light winds from the S.W. at 4 P.M. wind shifted to the S.W. & blew out to a gale but thick fog all day Barometer down to 28-2-10 middle and latter part fresh gale from the S.W.
