

Remarks on Board the

Saturday Jan 21st 1865
 Came in with moderate wind from the
 N.W. and pleasant a large ice from
 the Westward ship heading S.W. by W.
 Barometer on 29-2-10 middle part wind
 strong wind from the West and strong latter
 part fresh wind from the West and clear weather
 ship heading S.W. by W. Lat 57.55 N
 Long 76.06 W.

Sunday 22nd Came in with fresh breezes from
 the West and clear weather a bad ice in ship
 heading S.W. by W. Barometer stands on 29-3-10
 middle and latter part weather the same
 Lat 60.12 N
 Long 77.13 W.

Monday 23rd Came in with fresh breezes from
 West ship heading S.W. at 4 P.M. saw a
 ice Bank to the Southward five mile off
 new ship heading S.W. Barometer on
 29-2-10 middle part squally rain a big
 heading S.W. latter part strong winds from
 S.W. and squalls of hail and rain Lat 58.12 N
 Long 76.54 W.

Tuesday 24th Came in with moderate breezes from
 the West and squally ship heading S.W.
 middle part fresh wind from the West and strong
 for three hours then hauled to the West latter
 fresh wind from the West and squally
 Lat 58.31 N
 Long 77.14 W.

Barb Lactine off Cape Horn

Wednesday Jan 25th 1865
 Came in with a gale from the Westward and
 squally ship heading S.W. by W. Barometer
 on 28-8-10 middle and latter part fresh
 gale and heavy squalls from the N.W.
 Lat 58.25 N
 Long 78.46 W.

Thursday 26th Came in with fresh gale and heavy
 squalls from the S.W. Barometer on 28-8-10
 middle part the same at 11 P.M. began to
 moderate latter part light wind from the
 Southward and pleasant ships course S.W.
 Lat 57.48 N
 Long 78.13 W.

Friday 27th Came in with moderate wind from
 the Southward ships course S.W. Barometer
 on 28-9-10 middle part strong wind from
 S.W. ships course S.W. latter part moderate
 wind from the S.W. ship heading S.W. by W.
 Lat 57.21 N
 Long 77.41 W.

Saturday 28th Came in with strong wind from the
 West ship heading S.W. at 4 P.M. saw a
 island of ice to the south of our new ship
 heading S.W. by W. Barometer on 29-4-10
 middle gale from the West latter part the
 same at 7 P.M. kept off and steered E by S.
 Lat 57.41 N
 Long 77.50 W.

Sunday 29th Came in with fresh breezes and squalls
 from the West steering E by S. Barometer on
 29-1-10
