the S.W. and rainy rain in finbacks
middle and latter part light winds from
the S.E. and pleasant Lat 36.34 N

S.W. and pleasant saw Porpoise middle
and latter part squally and rainy Lat 36.57

Tuesday 28th Came in with fresh wind from the
S.W. and rigged saw many finbacks this
