Friday December 1st 1865

Came in with strong wind from the N.W. some rain and fog middle and latter part strong breezes Lat 36.24 N

Long 23.29 W

Saturday 2nd Came in with strong wind from the N.W. at 1 P.M. rose large sperm whales lived the Boat's mate Boat's streak and got captured lost the whale middle and latter part moderate speak the Bark Eliza Lat 36.26 N

Long 23.57 W

Sunday 3rd Came in with strong winds from the North dark cloudy weather saw two finbacks middle and latter part moderate gale from the N.W. Lat 36.39 N

Long 24.21 W

Monday 4th Came in with fresh breezes from the N.W. middle and latter part fresh gals from the N.W. Lat 36.50 N

Long 24.06 W

Tuesday 5th Came in with fresh gale from the N.W. middle and latter part the same Lat 36.09 N

Long 24.15 W

Wednesday 6th Came in with strong winds from the N.W. middle and latter part moderate wind from N.W. and pleasant Lat 35.50

Long 24.56

Thursday 7th Came in with moderate wind from the N.W. & pleasant saw finbacks middle part the same latter part strong breezes from the N.W. and foggy

The Bark Lactitia

Friday Dec 8th 1865

Came in with strong winds from the North and foggy at 4 P.M. wind shifted to the N.W. & cleared off middle part the same latter part fresh winds from the North Lat 37.30 N

Long 26.21 W

Saturday 9th Came in with fresh gals from the N.W. & rain squalls middle and latter part the same Lat 37.09

Long 25.26

Sunday 10th Came in with fresh gals from the N.W. Barometer stands on 29.12 = 10 middle and latter part fresh gals & squalls Lat 36.41

Long 24.46

Monday 11th Came in with fresh gals from the North Barometer stands 29.06 = 10 and rising middle and latter part weather the same latter part moderate Lat 36.04 N

Long 25.24 W

Tuesday 12th Came in with light winds from the N.W. saw a piece of squid middle part light winds from the North latter part a gale from the North saw a ship heading West at 10 A.M. saw two right whales going to the Standard squid too rugged to live the Boat's at midnight saw a small killers thus ends Lat by A. 37.00

Long by A. 26.00

Wednesday 13th Came in with fresh gals from the North & rainy at 6 P.M. wind shifted in a squall to the N.W. and cleared off middle and latter part fresh breezes from the N.W. and squall Lat 36.35 N
