Tuesday April 17th 1866

Came in with light wind from ESE and cloudy weather Ship heading NE middle and latter part strong breezes

Wednesday 18th Came in with strong breezes and rain squalls from the ESE ship heading SE middle and latter part the same

Thursday 19th Came in with strong wind from the SSE ship heading E middle and latter part light winds

Friday 20th Came in with light wind from the SSE ship heading ESE middle and latter part strong breezes from SSE ship heading E by S

Saturday 21st Came in with a gale from the North and rainy ship heading E middle part the same at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the SW latter part light winds from the SW

Sunday 22nd ant. Came in with light wind from the SSE ship heading E by S middle part calm latter part light winds from the SW

Monday 23rd Came in with light winds from the WSW ship course E by S middle part calm latter part strong wind from the SW and rainy

Tuesday April 24th 1866

Came in with strong wind from the SE and squally ship course E by S middle and latter part the same

Wednesday 25th Came in with fresh wind from the West at 4 P.M. wind shifted to the SW with heavy squalls middle part fresh gale middle and latter part the same ship course SE by E

Lat 38.03 N

Long 125.24 W

Thursday 26th Came in with a gale from the SW and squally ship course SE by E middle part the same latter part strong wind from the Westward

Lat 36.40 N

Long 122.05 W

Friday 27th Came in with moderate breezes from the SE dark cloudy weather ship course SE by E middle and latter part light airs and calms

Lat 35.56 N

Long 120.55 W

Saturday 28th Came in with light airs and calms middle part strong wind from the Eastward latter part fresh gals and rainy

Sunday 29th Came in with fresh gals from the Eastward and rainy middle part wind held to the North latter part fresh gals

Monday 30th Came in with fresh gals from the North at 3 P.M. wind held to the Westward middle and latter part a gale from the Westward ship course SE by E at 11 A.M. hauled to the wind under close reef main top sail
