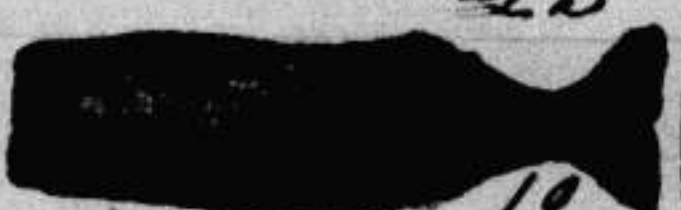
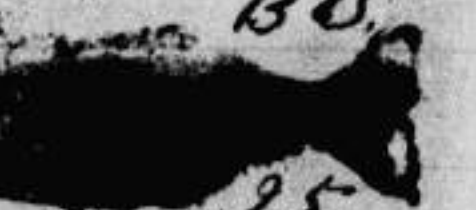


Whales seen and taken on the Virgin

Thursday Oct 24th

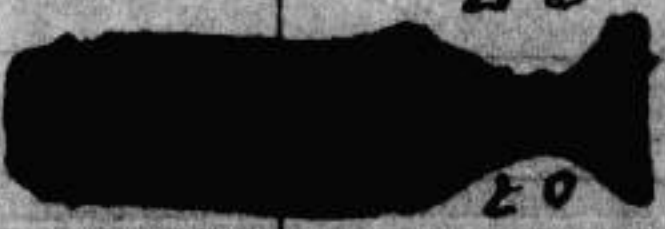
At 5 P.M. rose a school of whales

killed one Latt 1.55 N

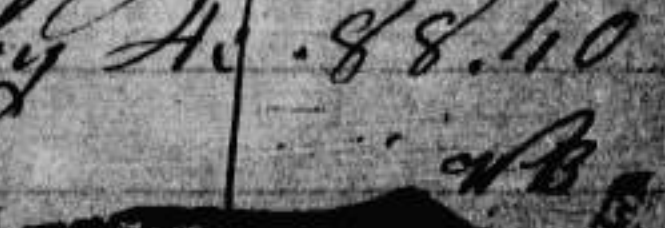
