

Ship La Fayette Towards

Sunday Nov 10th 1844
Commences with unsteady winds
from N.E. and squally weather
steering S.W. by W. saw Grampusses
Mia and Latta part squally with rain

Monday Nov 11th
light winds from N.E. and squally
weather steering S.W. by W. Mia and
Latta part rainy saw nothing

Tuesday Nov 12th
Commences with light winds and
thick weather steering S.W. by W.
Mia part moderate with light rain
Latta part fine and pleasant miles
from W. saw nothing of note

Wednesday Nov 13th
Commences with fine and pleasant
weather and light winds from W. by W.
steering S.W. by Compass. Mia part
thick foggy weather at 6 A.M. saw a
Brig steering to the N.E. Latta part
employed in repairing the W. Boat

Thursday Nov 14th
Commences with light winds from
N.E. and pleasant weather steering
S.W. employed in repairing the W. Boat
Mia part mia shifted to S.W. Latta part
fine and pleasant saw nothing

Friday Nov 15th
Commences with light breezes from
S.W. heading S.S.E. at 9. Came over to W.
Mia and Latta part light airs and calms

Cape Horn 1844

Saturday Nov 16th
Commences with light airs and calms
and cloudy weather a light swell bearing
from S.W. Mia part a light breeze from
S.S.E. Latta part the same saw some birds

Sunday Nov 17th
Commences with light breezes from S.
and clear weather bearing W. S. W. by the
Long Run 39.10 wind. Mia and Latta part fine and
Lunar 39.20 pleasant saw Hump Backs & Fin Backs

Monday Nov 18th
Fine and pleasant weather and light winds
from S.E. steering S.W. by saw some Fin Backs
Lunar 40.33 and Birds Mia and Latta part fine weather
Lunar 40.24 saw a Hump Back heaving

Tuesday Nov 19th
Commences with fine weather and
strong breezes from N.E. steering S.W.
Mia part the same at 7 A.M. saw a
Brig steering to the N.E. Latta part
quite hazy saw nothing

Wednesday Nov 20th
Commences with strong breezes from
N.E. and smoky weather steering S.W.
at 8 P.M. saw a Ship steering S.W. by W.
Mia and Latta part fine and
pleasant weather saw Hump Backs

Thursday Nov 21th
Fine and pleasant weather steering W. by S.
saw a Brig steering the same at night
Lunar 40.40 Shortened sail. Mia and Latta part
pleasant saw porpoises
