Saturday Nov 23rd
 Lat 37.18 S Commences with light air and
 Long 46.25 W calms saw a great many Porpoises
 at 6 P.M. saw Fin Backs lower
 and struck one at night cut the
 line. Mid and latter part calm.
 saw Porpoises

Sunday Nov 24th
 Commences with light air and
 Lat 38.18 S calm at 4 P.M. took a breeze from
 Long 47.18 W E.N.E. at 9 P.M. spoke Barque
 Ronke of Greenport 3 months
 160 of whale. Mid part moderate
 steering S.W. latter part strong breeze
 saw Fin Backs and Porpoises

Monday Nov 25th
 Commences with strong breeze
 Lat 40.00 S from E.N.E. and drove steering
 Long 49.11 W S.W. saw Fin Backs at night took
 in sail. Mid part moderate
 to a gale at 11 A.M. hove to the wind
 heading S.E. took in fore sail

Tuesday Nov 26th
 Lat 40.19 S Commences with a gale from E
 Long 51.55 W heading S.E. under close reef main
 top sail. Mid part moderate
 latter the same

 Commences with strong breeze from E.S.E.
 and ruggie weather heading N.E. by the
 Lat 39.40 S mid saw porpoises and Fin Backs
 Long 51.00 W Mid part moderate at 7 A.M. spoke Ship
 Massachusetts of New Bedford 80 days out
 150 Spinn latter part light air squalls
 saw Fin Backs

Thursday Nov 28th
 Commences with light air and calm
 at 5 P.M. took a breeze from N.W. at
 night took in sail. Mid part strong
 Lat 40.43 S breeze at daylight made sail and steered S.E.
 Long 51.50 W at 8 A.M. saw a sail at 9 A.M. hove to the
 wind first saw Royal Yacht and saw and
 ruggie S.G. Yacht and ruggie W.P. G. mast

Friday Nov 29th
 Commences with strong breeze from N.W.
 and ruggie heading S.W. by W at 3 P.M.
 Lat 40.56 S wind shifted to S at 6 P.M. spoke Ship
 Long 51.28 W Dartmouth 3 months out the Spinn
 at night took in sail. Mid part moderate
 at daylight made sail latter
 part light air and calm and pleasant

Saturday Nov 30th
 Commences with fine weather and
 Lat 41.23 light winds from N.W. steering S.E.
 Long 49.13 saw Porpoises at night took in sail
 steered S.E. by N at 6 A.M. hove to the wind
 heading S on bent the main top sail
 and top G. sail and bent new ones
