Lat 33.55 S Long 81.07 W
Light breeze from S.E. steering for Massafuis.
At 6 PM spoke Ship's Binigara in all parts of
our Beaufort 4 months 75 of Spinn. Misale and
Latter part moderate saw nothing but one sail

Saturday Jan 11th

Time and pleasant weather and light winds
from S.W. heading W at night took in sail
Distant 50 miles E.N.E. saw Ship to E.S.E. at 3 AM went off at daylight
saw the Land distant 40 miles Latter part
pleasant saw nothing of note

Sunday Jan 12th

Lat 34.38 Long 82.50
Light breeze from S.E. and pleasant heading
E.N.E. at 6 PM spoke Barque Mary Magdalen
N. Beaufort 34 months 700 Spinn. 1300 Whal
Latter part beautiful weather saw Fin Backs

Monday Jan 13th

Lat 34.44 Long 83.20
Time and pleasant weather with light winds
from E.N.E. steering S.W. saw Porpoises
Mistral part moderate Latter part calm
employed in on bending the new sails
and bending other ones saw Grampasses

Tuesday Jan 14th

Lat 34.07 Long 83.27
Light air and calm employed in bending
old sails Mid part moderate at daylight
saw 3 sail steering to the E. Latter part
employed in getting up the cutting Benavente
and Quis

Wednesday Jan 15th

Lat 36.00 Long 82.00
Commenced with fine and pleasant weather
and smooth sea steering S.E. Mid part
the same Latter part thick weather and
strong breeze from N.W. saw nothing

Thursday Jan 16th

Lat 36.20 Long 80.00 W
Whirl weather with the same from N.W. wind layed
in washing ship steering E by N at night shortened
sail Mid part pleasant Latter part some light
rain squalls washed the out side the ship

Friday Jan 17th

Lat 36.25 Long 79.19
Commenced with light winds from W with light
rain squalls at 9 AM heaved to the wind and
layed aback until daylight man sail and
steer E by N Latter part moderate saw nothing

Saturday Jan 18th

Lat 34.58 Long 79.55
Commenced with fine and pleasant weather and
steady wind from S steering N.W. at night took in
sail Mid part strong breeze heading N.S.W.
Latter part fine and pleasant steering N.W.
Saw nothing of note

Sunday Jan 19th

Time and pleasant weather and light winds from
S steering N.W. at 6 PM saw the Island of
Massafuis Mid part moderate Latter part
steer in for the Land saw Fin Backs

Monday Jan 20th

Lat 34.00 Long 80.00 W
Light air and calm at 1 PM went on shore
Land dist. to Fish at 8 PM returned with a barrell
of good fish Mid part thick and rainy
at 12 night strong breeze from E.S.E.
Latter part the same steering N
