

Ship La Fayette on Chili 1845

Tuesday Jan 21st

Lat. 32.12 Strong wind from S.E. and rough sea steering
Long 80.35 or at night shortened sail and steered to the
wind heading N.E. at daylight made all
sail and steered N. or rather past pleasant

Wednesday Jan 22nd

Commenced with fine and pleasant weather
Lat. 31.30 S and light winds from S.E. steering N.W. & E
Long 79.50 W saw a Bird Steaming to the E. Side and
Latter part moderate employed in painting
the outside the Ship saw nothing

Thursday Jan 23rd

Lat. 30.30 S Fine and pleasant weather and light winds from
Long 79.10 W steering N.W. & E employed in painting
the outside the Ship. Much part moderate
Latter part the same saw nothing of note

Friday Jan 24th

Lat. 29.33 Commenced with fine and pleasant weather and
Long 78.11 light winds from W.S.W. steering N.W. & E
employed in painting the Spar Boats
Midday and Latter part pleasant saw
nothing of note

Saturday Jan 25th

Lat. 28.33 Light air and calm at 3 P.M. much breeze
Long 77.44 up from S.E. Much part long by until 4 P.M.
made all sail and steered N.W. & E at 9 A.M.
saw Black Fish larvae and caught 1
Latter strong breeze & sail in sight steering
by the N.E. & W.

La Fayette Honors Peru 1845

Sunday Jan 26th

Lat. 26.57 S Strong breeze from S.E. with passing clouds steering
Long 78.58 W N.W. & W saw a Barque steering by the N.W. to S.W.
at night shortened sail and steered N.W. & W. at 4 P.M.
Latter part strong saw 1 Fin Back 20 km

Monday Jan 27th

Lat. 25.53 Commenced with thick cloudy weather steering
Long 78.00 N.W. at 4 P.M. saw the Island of Sanhosia
distant 40 miles at 7 shortened sail steered
N.E. Latter part the same saw a Ship steering
to the N.W.

Tuesday Jan 28th

Lat. 25.00 Commenced with fine and pleasant weather at 3 P.M.
Long 76.40 spoke Ship Channeler Prior of N. Beaufort & 2 months
70 lbs whal oil Latter part pleasant saw Black
Fish larvae and caught 2

Wednesday Jan 29th

Lat. 24.11 Fine and pleasant weather and light winds from S.E.
Long 76.04 steering N.E. by E at night took in sail and were short
to S.E. at 3 P.M. were N.E. Latter part pleasant
saw nothing of note

Thursday Jan 30th

Lat. 23.21 Fine weather and steady breeze from S.E. steering
Long 75.00 N.W. by E saw Campufes at night shortened sail
Latter part took in S. Boat to repair saw 1 Fin Back

Friday Jan 31st

Lat. 21.47 Commenced with fine weather steering N.W. & E
Long 73.49 employed in repairing the S. Boat at 7 P.M.
took in sail steered N.W. by W Latter part steered
N.E. saw nothing of note
