Saturday Feb 1st

Lat. 20.30 S Long 73.03
 Commenced with fine weather with light breezes from S.E. steering S.E. by E at night shortened sail. Mid past cloudy. Latter part employed in painting the S. Boat saw no fish.

Sunday Feb 2nd

Lat. 20.27 S Long 71.43.44
 Fine and pleasant steering E saw a sail steering S.W. at 2 PM passed on the concave at night shortened sail. Mid past lay heading S.E. with the head yards aback at dayfall the main sail steered E by N latter part saw Porpoises.

Monday Feb 3rd

Lat. 20.17 Long 70.14
 Light winds from S.W. and cloudy weather steering E by N at 4 PM saw the Lona bearing E distant 40 miles. Mid past lay heading W.S.W. at daylight made all sail heading W. Latter part calm saw nothing of note.

Tuesday Feb 4th

Lat. 19.20 Long 71.40
 Light airs and calms at 3 PM light breezes from S steering N.W. Mid past thick cloudy weather. Latter part calm and very warm saw Grampuses.

Wednesday Feb 5th

Lat. 18.47 Long 72.28
 Commenced with light airs and calms and very warm. Mid past light breezes from S.E. Latter part light breezes from N. saw Porpoises.

Thursday Feb 6th

Lat. 18.33 S Long 72.55 W
 Light airs and calms saw Porpoises and Grampuses steering W. or W. with a light swell from S.W.

Friday Feb 7th

Lat. 18.05 Long 74.02
 Light airs and calms at 1 PM luvina and caught a Sun Fish. Mid past cloudy at 6 PM saw Black Fish going quick to the S. Latter part pleasant saw nothing of note.

Saturday Feb 8th

Lat. 16.57 S Long 75.02
 Commenced with light breezes from S.E. and fine weather steering N.W. saw Lona Fish luvina and chased them. Mid and latter part fine and pleasant saw Porpoises.

Sunday Feb 9th

Lat. 15.50
 Fine and pleasant weather and smooth sea steering N. at night shortened sail at 10 PM. Lona dist 30 miles. Ship to W. Latter part pleasant steering in for the Lona at 11 AM luvina the boat and caught a Lona Fish.

Monday Feb 10th

Lat. 15.27
 Light winds and fine weather steering N.W. saw Lona Backs at 5 PM luvina to the Lona. Dist 15 miles heading S. Mid past light airs and calms at 2 PM saw Ship to S.E. Latter part saw Fin Backs and Lona Backs.

Tuesday Feb 11th

Lat. 15.40
 Fine and pleasant weather and light winds from S.E. Mid past strong breezes and clear. Latter part steered N.W. employed in getting fresh water out the gunn the cask and filling them with salt water.
