at night took in sail at 9 PM saw a ship  
steering by the mine to S.W. latter part saw  
Black Fish and Flump Bucks

Fine and pleasant weather and steady breeze  
steering W at night took in sail. This and  
latter part steered W.N.W. near a sail  
steering to the E.N.E.

Steady breeze from S.E. steering W.N.W. at night  
shortened sail and heaved to the wind heading  
S.S.W. at 12 midnight saw ship to S.E. at  
daylight made all sail and steered N.W. by W  
latter part pleasant saw Fin Bucks and  
Porpoises

Fine and pleasant weather steering N.W. by W  
saw a ship steering to S.W. employed in  
restoring the between decks at night  
heaved to the wind latter part saw nothing  
steering N.W. by W

Fine and pleasant weather and light breeze  
steering N.W. by W at night shortened sail  
Mid and latter part pleasant saw nothing

Fine weather heading S.S.W. at 1 PM saw  
Black Fish hoveed and caught 3. Mid and  
latter part steady breeze saw Black Fish  
and Fin Buckle

Tuesday Feb 18<sup>th</sup>

Fine and pleasant weather heading to S.S.W.  
by the mine at 6 PM turned to E.N.E. latter  
part employed in taring rigging saw Black Fish

Wednesday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light breeze at E.S.E. heading  
N.E. Mid part steady breeze at 6 AM saw  
ship to S.S.W. latter part employed in taring  
rigging saw nothing of the mine

Lat 11. 35 S  
Long 80. 30 W

Thursday Feb 20<sup>th</sup>

Fine weather and steady breeze heading S.S.W.  
Mid part the same at 7 AM saw ship to E.N.E.  
latter part strong breeze with passing clouds

Lat 12. 29 S  
Long 80. 38 W

Friday Feb 21<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine and pleasant weather  
and light breeze from S.E. heading E.N.E.  
at 4 PM steered off W by W. Mid and latter  
part pleasant saw some Black Fish steering N.W. by W

Lat 11. 00 S  
Long 80. 39 W

Saturday Feb 22<sup>th</sup>

Fine and pleasant steering N.W. by W. Mid  
and latter part the same saw nothing  
but Fly Fish

Sunday Feb 23<sup>th</sup>

Pleasant weather and light winds from S.E.  
steering N.W. Mid and latter part some  
light rain squalls saw nothing

Lat 9. 33

Monday Feb 24<sup>th</sup>

Fine and pleasant winds light at S.E. steering N.W.  
Mid part some light rain squalls at 6 AM  
saw 2 sails steering by the mine to S.S.W.
