Monday June 2nd

Commenced with fine and pleasant weather and light winds at S.E. at 6 P.M. the Boat came on Board with 4 terpin. This part the minor light at 7 A.M. saw sperm Whales going quick to S.E. however and chased at 9 came on board

Tuesday June 3rd

Commenced with fine weather and light winds from S.E. heading S.S.W. at 3 P.M. tacked to E.N.E. 1 ship in sight at 11 M. tacked off from the Lane at 1 A.M. tacked to S.E. latter part moderate fine the current setting us to S.W. with all sail out by the wind saw some Black Fish

Wednesday June 4th

Fine and pleasant weather and light winds from S.E. heading E.N.E. at 4 P.M. tacked off Lane distant 8 miles. This and latter part calm saw Porpoises the same ship in sight

Thursday June 5th

Commenced with light breezes at S.E. heading to S.E. by E. at night tacked Ship to S. and single reefed the Top Sails. This part moderate latter part strong breezes steering N by W

Friday June 6th

Commenced with fine weather and strong breezes from S. steering N at 2 P.M. saw a Barque steering by the wind to E. This part calm latter part light airs from S. saw Porpoises and Black Fish

Light airs and calms within 4 miles of Portborough at 5 P.M. light breezes from N.W. until 10 then calm the remainder of the 24 hours saw B. Fish and Porpoises

Sunday June 8th

Rock Beacon Commenced with light airs and calms steering N. the or. This part calm at 6 A.M. saw sperm Whales however and struck 1 at 11 A.M. took him to the Ship 2 sail in sight

Monday June 9th

Light airs and calms at 1 P.M. commenced cutting at 2 finished main sail heading S.E. at 7 P.M. spoke Ship John Adams of San Francisco 11 1/2 months ago. This part moderate latter part employed in boiling

South Head

Tuesday June 10th

Light breezes from S. heading E.S.E. at 3 P.M. spoke Ship Omega of Portchester 8 months out 120 lbs at 2 A.M. from there boiling latter part calm 3 ships in sight

Wednesday June 11th

Commenced with light airs and calm 3 sails in sight. This part same at 11 A.M. saw a large Whale going to the N.W. at 12 noon lowered the boats for him

Thursday June 12th

Light airs and calm at 2 P.M. struck the whale at 5 P.M. took him to the Ship. This part light breezes from S. at 5 A.M. commenced cutting latter part strong breezes employed in cutting 5 ships in sight
