Friday June 13th

Lat 1 00.00 Commenced with strong breeze employees in cutting at 4 P.M. finished at 10.00 commenced boiling. Latter the same

Saturday June 14th

Lat 1.32.00 Commenced with fine and pleasant weather employees in boiling heading E.S.E. Mice and Lat 93.00 Latter part the same 1 sail in sight

Sunday June 15th

Lat 1.22.00 Fine weather and light breeze from S at 1 P.M. Lat 93.23 Tacked ship to E.S.E. Mice part moderate at 9 A.M. finished boiling saw two Backs

Monday June 16th

Lat 1.14.00 Fine and pleasant weather and steady winds from S heading E.S.E. Mice part same at 6 Lat 92.45 A.M. commenced stowing oil Latter part pleasant saw nothing

Tuesday June 17th

Lat 53 miles or heading E.S.E. employees in stowing oil Mice Lat 91.50.00 pleasant weather and light winds from S and Latter part the same

Wednesday June 18th

North Head dist 30 miles Light winds from S heading E.S.E. employees in stowing oil Mice part pleasant Latter part same saw Black Fish and 3 sails 1 of the Boiling

Thursday June 19th

Lat 10 miles or Head dist 10 miles Light wind and cloudy weather at 2 P.M. finished stowing oil 2 sails in sight at 6 P.M. Tacked off from the Land Mice part pleasant Latter part cloudy

La Fayette off Galapagos

Friday June 20th

Commenced with fine and pleasant weather Lat 15 miles heading in for the Land at 4 P.M. spoke the South Omega Mice part moderate Latter part the Land 15 to 20 miles to ship in sight

Saturday June 21st

Clear weather and strong winds from S strong or Lat 09 miles at 4 P.M. saw the John Adams in pursuit of whales at 5 P.M. launched the Boats for the whales which sounded and ran very bad after dark cut the line Mice part strong breeze and ruggen Latter part the same saw nothing

Sunday June 22nd

Commenced with strong breeze from S and clear weather heading W.S.W. at 8 P.M. Tacked ship to E.S.E. the John Adams in sight Mice part ruggen Latter part steered off N.P.E. at 12 noon saw whales

Monday June 23rd

Light airs and calms at 1 P.M. launched the Roande Rock Boats for whales and caught 2 at 5 P.M. got them dist 5 miles to the ship Mice part moderate at 5 A.M. commenced cutting at 8 A.M. finished 2 sail in sight

Tuesday June 24th

Light airs and calms at 3 P.M. sent a Boat to the Rock for fish Mice part light breeze from S at 6 A.M. commenced boiling Latter part light airs and calms 6 ships in sight

Wednesday June 25th

Lat 10 miles dist 10 miles Light airs and calms at 6 P.M. spoke ship messenger of Owen Beaufort 23 miles 600 Mpm at 5 A.M. finished boiling
