were ship to N.E. Mice past squally at 9 A.M.

Backs & Porpoises

Long 98.43 Backs. Mice past moderate Lather past pleasant
employed in cutting oil

Sunday Nov 23rd

Lat. 5.57 Fine and pleasant weather heading S at 2 P.M. saw
Long 99.34 Breaches 7 or 8 miles distant at sunset made them out
to be sperm whales at 1 A.M. tacked ship to N.E.
at daylight saw a whale half a mile off the ship
going to S.E. appeared to be frequented by Porpoises
between and chased without success
