Long 147.00 " saw Fin Backs

Friday July 10

Rigged with a heavy swell from S.E.
at 9 A.M. saw a sail steering S. Lotte part
Long 147.03 " saw nothing

Saturday July 11th

Strong breeze from N.W. steering S.E.
Mia part raining, Lotte part men
Long 146.35 " moderate but thick saw no fish

Sunday July 12th

Commenced with light air and calms
saw some Fin Backs. Mia and Lotte
Long 147.30 " part thick fog, most of the time saw 1
sail

Monday July 13th

Light breeze from N.W. at 6 P.M. saw 1
Long 147.20 " whale linnec and charca. Mia and
Lotte part strong breeze and thick weather
saw nothing

Tuesday July 14th

Strong breeze from S.W. and thick weather
Long 147 " steering N.W. Mia and Lotte part men
moderate saw nothing

Strong breeze from N.W. and rigged
Long 147 " saw nothing

Lotte employed in cutting

Saturday July 18th

Thick foggy weather employed in cutting
Long 147.00 " at 3 P.M. finished and commenced boiling
Mia part rigged at 6 A.M. saw the Boat
for whales

Sunday July 19th

Strong breeze and rain at 3 P.M. spoke ship
Long 147 " Good Return of the Beaufort 24 months 2100
Mia part calm at 4 A.M. saw whales linnec
and struck 1 which saved the Boat

Monday July 20th

Light air and calms at 1 P.M. linnec and
Long 147.00 " got a whale. Mia part calm with fog at 4 A.M.
commenced cutting. Lotte part the same

Tuesday July 21st

Employed in cutting at 2 P.M. finished and
Long 147.00 " commenced boiling. Mia and Lotte part the
same

Strong breeze from S.W. and rigged employees
Long 147.00 " in boiling. Mia and Lotte part the same
