Saturday, July 25th

Lat. 57.40 " Employees in storing oil Mice part foggy
Long 147.00 " Lotta put the same

Sunday, July 26th

Lat. 57.40 " Thick weather and light mists employees in
Long 147.00 " Storing oil at 6 PM finished Mice part calm
at 6 AM lowered the Boats for Whales

Monday, July 27th

Lat. 57.45 " Light breezes and fine weather at 1 PM struck
Long 147.00 " and killed a whale which sunk Mice part
calm at 6 AM lowered the Boats and struck
2 whale crew the men from 1 got fast him
and cut from the other

Tuesday, July 28th

Lat. 58.08 " Light air and calms and plenty of
Long 146.30 " Ships and Whales at 1 PM lowered the Boats
at 5 PM struck 1 cut the line off in lowering
the whale at 7 AM struck another which was
bad cut the line

Lat. 58.04 " Calm weather at 7 PM struck and got
Long 146.20 " a whale Mice part calm at 6 AM commenced
cutting at 10 AM finished at 11 AM

Friday, July 31st

Lat. 58.10 " Light breezes and foggy employees in boiling
Long 145.30 " Mice part rainy at 4 AM saw 1 whale however
and sunk him Lotta part saw Fin Backs

Saturday, Aug 1st

Lat. 58.10 " Light breezes from S.W. and thick weather
Long 145.20 " employees in boiling at 4 PM spoke Barque
J.B. Donnell of N.E. Beaford 3 months 120 tons
also Ship Marcia 7 Whales this season Mice
and Lotta part a gale from W

Sunday, Aug 2nd

Lat. 58.14 " Commenced with a gale from W Mice part
Long 146.00 " more moderate Lotta part employees in storing oil

Monday, Aug 3rd

Lat. 57.17 " Light air and calms several Ships in sight Mice
Long 145.00 " and Lotta part light breezes from N.W. and fine
weather employees in setting up shocks

Tuesday, Aug 4th

Lat. 57.31 " Fine and pleasant weather with light breezes
Long 146.07 " from N.W. heading N.E. Mice part the
same at 5 AM were N.W. Lotta part
pleasant saw nothing of note

Wednesday, Aug 5th

Lat. 58.20 " Fine and pleasant heading N.W. saw nothing but
Long 147.30 " Fin Backs Lotta part some fog 1 Ship in
sight
