steering S.E. by E. Mia and Latta part
rugged all start set

Sunday Sept 6th

Strong breeze from N.W. and cloudy weather
steering S.E. by E. Mia part much the same
Latta part more moderate saw nothing

Monday Sept 7th

Commences with light breezes from N.W. and
cloudy weather steering S.E. by E. all sail set
to the best advantage Mia and Latta part
much the same saw nothing of note

Light breezes from N.W. and smooth sea steering
S.E. by E. Mia and Latta part much the same
Latta part saw nothing

Light breezes from N.W. and smooth sea

Friday Sept 11th

Commences with light winds from N. and
cloudy weather steering S.E. & S. Mia and
Latta part much the same saw Porpoises
and Black Fish

Saturday Sept 12th

Strong breeze from N.W. and cloudy weather steering
S.E. & S. Mia part the same Latta part thick and
raining saw nothing

Sunday Sept 13th

Strong winds from N. with thick rainy weather
at 5 P.M. took in sail and heaved to the wind Mia
part a gale from N.W. at 5 A.M. made sail and
steered S.E. Latta part strong breezes from N.
and squally

Monday Sept 14th

Strong breezes from N.W. and squally weather
steering S.E. by E. at 9 P.M. took in the steering
sail Mia part heavy squalls Latta part
more moderate made all sail saw nothing

Tuesday Sept 15th

Commenced with light winds from S.E. & N. and
pleasant steering S.E. Mia part moderate
Latta part the wind from N. with a heavy swell
from S.W. saw nothing
