

Ship La Fayette on Western Ground

Sunday Feb 14th

Fine weather at 2 PM took the whale
Lat 5.38. to the ship and commenced cutting at night
Long 105.50. finished the body. Mia past strong breezes
and reggae at 4 AM commenced and
cut the piece Latta past very reggae

Monday Feb 15th

Very reggae employed in boiling, and
Lat 5.5. cutting up the whale Latta past man
Long 106.20. moderate employed in setting up shocks

Tuesday Feb 16th

Strong breeze from S.E. heading E.N.E.
Lat 4.28. employed in boiling. Mia past the same
Long 106.44. at 10 AM finished boiling

Wednesday Feb 17th

Lat 4.5-8 Commenced with fine weather heading
Long 105.48. N.E. Mia and Latta past the same

Thursday Feb 18th

Fine weather and light winds from
Lat 4.52. S.E. at 4 PM were ship to S. Mia past
Long 107.00. the same Latta past employed in cooking
oil and stowing down

Friday Feb 19th

Strong wind at E.S.E. employed in
Lat 5.41. stowing oil. Mia past heavy storms
Long 107.20. of rain Latta past reggae double
refuse the top sails

Saturday Feb 20th

Lat 5.20 Strong breeze at S.E. and reggae Mia and
Long 107.40 Latta past the same saw nothing

Sunday Feb 21st

Strong winds and reggae heading N.E.
Lat 5.00. at 4 PM out the hole Mia and Latta
Long 108.20. past man moderate saw nothing

Monday Feb 22nd

Fine weather and steady winds at S.E. heading
Lat 5.44. S. S.E. at 6 AM were ship to N.E. Latta
Long 108.45. past strong winds and reggae saw nothing

Tuesday Feb 23rd

Lat 5.28. Strong winds and reggae saw nothing.
Long 108.23. of note

Wednesday Feb 24th

Strong winds at E.S.E. heading N.E. at 5 PM
Lat 5.00. saw a sail Mia and Latta past strong
Long 108.40. winds saw nothing of note

Thursday Feb 25th

Fine and pleasant heading S by the winds
Lat 6.00. at 6 AM were ship to N.E. Latta past
Long 108.49. saw nothing

Friday Feb 26th

Fine and pleasant heading N.E.
Lat 5.26. all sail set Mia and Latta past
Long 108.30. the same saw some Porpoises
