Friday April 23rd

Lat 36. 41

Light winds from N.W. Steering E. N. E
Mia part thick and rainy weather
Sail at 6 AM saw the Estancia de Maria
at about 20 miles Lathe part moderate

Saturday April 24th

Garigueano
Distance 3 miles

Light winds from N.W. and fine weather
Steering E. N. E at 9 AM saw ship of the
Mia part thick and rainy at daylight
made sail steered in for the land
Lathe part pleasant but the chains

Sunday April 25th

Light winds from N.W. steering in for
the harbor at 4 PM came to in
Talcahuano Bay in 6 fathoms muddy
bottom

Saturday May 8th

Lat 36. 19
Long 73. 40

Light air from S.W. at 1 PM got
under weigh and steered out the Bay
Mia and Lathe part light air and
calms with fog on both the chains
and lashed the anchors

Sunday May 9th

Lat 35. 10
Long 74. 00

Light air and calms with fog
Mia and Lathe part calm

Monday May 10th

Lat 35. 40
Long 76. 00

Light breeze from N and foggy steering
S. by W Mia part the same Lathe
part strong breeze and rainy saw
a ship heading to the E

Lat 37. 35
Long 78. 20
Strong breeze from N.E and thick rain
weather steering S.W. Mia part the same at 11 AM
mua shifted to S saw a ship bound S

Wednesday May 12th

Strong breeze from S heading E.S.E at 3 PM
Lat 38. 04
Long 79. 00
Mia part the S.W. at 5 PM could see
the top sails Mia part a very heavy swell
from S.W. at 5 AM saw ship to S.S.E
mua inclining to the W Lathe part pleasant

Thursday May 13th

Light wind from N.W. and pleasant
steering S by W Mia part a gale
from N and rainy at 3 AM mia shifted
Lat 39. 47
Long 80. 28
to N.W. Lathe part moderate with a
high swell from W 1 ship in sight
steering S.S.W

Friday May 13th

Lat 40. 48
Long 80. 42
Light winds from N with a heavy swell
from W steering S by W Mia part rainy
Lathe part light air and calms

Saturday May 14th

Lat 42. 04
Long 80. 50
Light air and calms at 3 PM mia from
S.W. heading S.E Mia part mia shifted
to W.S.W Lathe part strong breeze and
squally

Sunday May 15th

Strong breeze from N.W. steering S by W
Lat 43. 44
Long 81. 33
mia inclining to the N Mia part a gale
from the N at 3 AM mia shifted to W.S.W
Lathe part a gale being made close reef
Main top sail and reef fore sail
