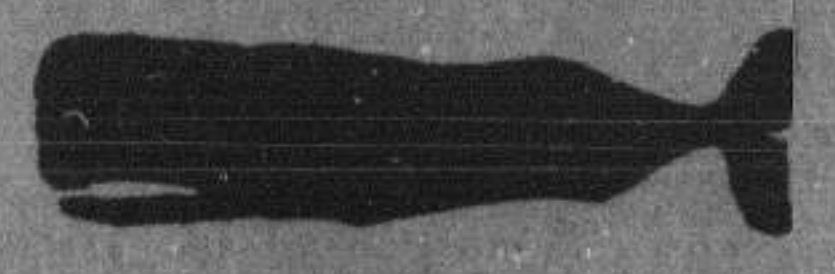

Ship Lalla Rookh June 16th 1837

Friday 16th At 4 P.M. sea account got under way
with a small breeze from N and
steered out to sea at 2 A.M. discharged
the pilot latter part small breeze
from N.W. at 8 A.M. Vanans Land
bearing N.W. dist 12 miles from
which I take my departure at noon
saw a number of fishing vessels thousands

Saturday 17 Small breezes from N.W. with thick
weather at 4 P.M. spoke ship Hyde as per
of New Bedford latter part strong breezes
from N. courses steered S. Lat 40.20 N

Sunday 18 Strong breezes from N. courses steered
by compass & all hands employed in
ships duty masts this day

Monday 19 Strong breezes from N.W. at 10 A.M. saw
blackfish caught 2 courses steered
by compass & Lat 39.17 N 65.00

Tuesday 20 first part light breezes from N.W.
at 7 A.M. saw blackfish caught 2
No obs. this day

Wednesday 21 First part strong heavy winds from S.W.
at 2 P.M. close reefed top sails at 8 P.M.
lookin fore 4 mizen top sails & fore sail
hove two under main top sail and
stay sails at 8 A.M. more moderate
made sail revinds. I courses steered
S.W. Lat 40.8 Long 63.00.

Thursday 22 Strong breezes from S.W. with heavy
spralls at 8 A.M. hove two heavy galls
from S.W. Lat 41.00 Long 64.00
