from S.W. to S.E. at 6 P.M.
took in top gallant sails
and flew the middle part
specially latter part strong
winds from S.W. two ships
in sight all steering to the
S. by the wind Lat 8.29.19.55

Saturday 29

thick rainy weather and
calm all this day sun obscured

Sunday 30

first part calm middle
and latter part moderate
breeze from S.W. by W. with
clear weather all drawing
sail set to advantage steering
S.W. Lat 6.15. N Long 17.45.3

Monday 31st

Strong winds from S.W. by S
large swell from S. ships head
to the S. eastward all sail set
to advantage Lat 5.18. N Long 15.41.10

to the W. latter part
