- Aug 7th Strong heavy trades from S.E. with heavy squalls at 6. P.M. took in top gallant sails at 10. A.M. double reefed top sails large sea from S.E. Lat 11.19. S Long 28.57.45 W
- Thursday 10 Strong trades from S.E. at 10 A.M. out reefs & set top gallant sails Ship's head to the S.W. ward Lat 13.20. S Long 30.11.16
- Friday 11th Brist trades from S.E. & S. latter part moderate with clear weather at 4. A.M. saw a ship to windward Missing Ely. N Lat 15.11.31.45 W
- Saturday 12 Commenced with strong trades from S.E. large heavy swell from S.W. latter part light breezes and calms heavy swell from S.W. Lat 16.44.32.57.15
- Sunday 13th First part small breezes from S. all appearance of a heavy wind from S.E. at 7. P.M. greatly weathered latter part clear pleasant weather winds from S.E. with passing clouds Lat 17.41. S Long 34.05.
- Monday 14 Fine pleasant weather winds from E. by S. Lat 18.38-36.06 W
- Tuesday 15 Moderate breezes E. by S. fine & serene weather saw great quantities of finbacks Lat 20.15. —

- Wednesday 16 Small breezes from S. with clear weather at 6. A.M. saw two ships one to windward and one to leeward Missing S.W. at 5. P.M. saw a sperm whale going to the S.W. Lat 22.00 Long 35.09
- Thursday 17 Moderate breezes with pleasant weather at 1. P.M. spoke a french whale ship 44 days from France bound to coast of Chile latter part fine weather winds from N.E. and light Lat 23.13. S Long 33.20.
- Friday 18th Clear pleasant weather all this day with a S.W. sea winds from N.W. ship's head to the S.W. in played in painting boats and other ships duty Lat 24.22. S Long 31.13.25
- Saturday 19 Brist breezes from N at 5. A.M. saw a ship ahead at noon past her courses steered by compass S.E. latter part Lat 24.47 Long 29.09
- Sunday 20 Moderate breezes with fair weather winds from N.W. latter part strong heavy winds from N.W. with a large sea at 6. A.M. saw a ship ahead at 2. P.M. past her Lat 25.54.
