Wednesday 23 Moderate breezes from N.E. with a heavy swell from N.W. Latter part calm saw quantity of sea fowl Lat 28.58. Long by Chron. 19.57.30

Thursday 24 Light air and calms all this day large swell from S.W. at 7 A.M. saw ship to the S.W. at noon calm Lat 27.50. S Long 18.40.12

Friday 24th First part calm middle part light air from N. Latter part quick breeze from N.W. ship's head to the S.W. Lat 28.25. Long 17.51.15—

Saturday Strong heavy winds from N.W. with a heavy sea and squally weather. Latter part clear weather with passing clouds Lat 29.44. S Long 14.59.15—

Towards South Pacific Ocean August

Sunday 26 Strong winds from S.W. at 6 P.M. took in striding sails and top gallant sails at 11 P.M. heavy gale of wind from S.W. ship's head to the S.W. at 7 A.M.

Moved the quarter boat at 8 A.M. brought the ship to the wind under close reefed maintop sail and staysails heavy gale from S.W. Lat 28.50.44. Long 12.40

Monday 27 Commenced with a gale of wind at 1 P.M. more moderate at fore topsail and fore sail at 6 A.M. winds from S. and moderate out reefs and lettop gallant sails heavy swell from S.W. Lat 30.43. Long 11.54

Tuesday 28 First part light bofing winds middle part calm large swell from S. latter part light breeze from N.W. ship's head to the S.W. Lat 30.43. 10.20. W?

Wednesday 29 Moderate breezes from N large swell from S.W. middle part thick weather heavy swell from S.W. latter part quick breeze from N.W. Lat at noon 31.57. Long 11.45. W

Thursday 31 Brought out this day strong heavy winds from N.W. all morning sail letting off clear weather with passing clouds Lat 34.00. Long 6.41
