Wednesday 13 First part clear weather and pleasant
 Moderate breeze from W. at 4 P.M.
 Saw a quantity of black whales
 water very much discoloured
 latter part small breeze from
 N.W. course steered by compass ~~S.W.~~
 S.W. ship's company employed in
 repairing boats at 11 A.M. sent up
 fore top gallant yard made and
 took in sail as requisite
 Lat 38.03 S Long 26.45.15 E

Thursday 14 Small breeze from W. S.W. large
 swell from S.W. ship's head
 to the S.W. at 6 A.M. saw one

Saturday 16 Strong heavy winds from N
 at 6 P.M. close reefs top sails
 took in main sail courses
 Reeds S.W. at 2 A.M. saw a long
 Lat 38.15 S Long 39.45.45 E

Towards Pacific Ocean on a whale voyage
 Sunday 17 Strong heavy winds from N
 Middle part the same under
 close reefs fore and main
 top sails and fore sail steering
 S.W. S.W. at 6 A.M. calm and
 thick rainy weather at 7 A.M.
 saw a ship supposed to be
 a whale ship at 11 A.M. saw
 a quantity of right whales
 small breeze from W. S.W.
 Lat 38.13 S Long 41.57. E

Monday 18 First part strong heavy winds
 from S.W. at 4 P.M. double
 reefs top sails Middle part
 squally winds from S. at 8 A.M.
 wind S.W. employed in breaking
 out after hole to trim ship
 Lat 38.13 S Long 44.27. E

Tuesday 19 Strong breezes from S.W. at
 6 P.M. double reefs top sails
 took in main course and
 spanker wore ship to the
 S.W. middle part strong
 winds at 11 A.M. saw a bark
 to the N.W. steering S.W.
 strong winds and squally
 sun obs Long by Lat 45.35

Wednesday 20 Strong heavy winds from N.W.
 this day at 9 A.M. out reefs
 let top gallant sails courses
 steered S.W. S.W. large swell
 from N Lat 38.45 S Long 50.30
