from S.W. at 6. A.M. rose ship
and sung N.E. by N

S.E. at 6 P.M. rose ship to
the S.W. at 6. A.M. commenced
rowing down in the main
hatchway latter part calm

throughout this day calm
small swell, sails 1.20
all hands employed in
rowing down main hatch
way. Lat 20.57. Long 110.34

Monday 30. First part calm latter part fine
pleasant weather small breeze
from S.E. at 4 P.M. finished
rowing down ship's head
to the S.W. Lat 20.40. S. Long 112.12.11

Tuesday 31. fine pleasant weather small
swell from S.W. ship's head to
the S.W. at 7 P.M. hove two
with the ship's head to the west
latter part steering to the S.W.

Wednesday Nov. 1. Moderate breeze from S.E.
with clear pleasant weather
ship's head to the S.W.

Lat 19.49. S. Long 114.49

Thursday 2. Moderate breeze with
fine weather ship's head
to the S.W. at 6 P.M.

to late to lower Lat 19.01. Long 115.19.11

Friday 3. Moderate breeze with fine pleasant
weather small swell from S.W.
wind from S.E. to S. saw grampuses
and dolphin ship to the eastward
Lat 18.36. S. Long 116.10.15 E.

Saturday 4. Strong breeze from S.W.
calm at 11 P.M. as weather
saw number of fin backs
Lat 18.01. Long 118.40

Sunday 5. Moderate breeze from S.W.
at 2 P.M. hove the wind
to the S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked
ship to the west beating up
for the N.W. Cape Lat 18.34. S. Long 118.01.

Monday 6. Strong wind from S.W.
all possible sail carried
to get to windward. Strong
current setting to the N.

Lat 18.09. S. Long 116.30

Tuesday 7. Strong wind from S.W.
strong current setting to N.E.
Lat 18.51. Long 118.25

Wednesday 8. Strong wind from S.W.
one reef in the top sails
ship's head to the N.W. as
employed in ship's duty.
as usual Lat 18.05. S. Long 116.34. E.

Thursday 9. Moderate breeze from S.W.
ship to the eastward small
swell from S.W. saw nothing
Lat 17.55. S. Long 115.44.50 E.

Friday 10. Moderate breeze from S.W.
at 6 P.M. tacked ship to
the S.E. at 3. A.M. to the S.W.
strong current setting to
the N.E. Lat 17.45. S.
