- Saturday 11. Small breezes from S.W. to S.E. Ships head to the westward. Saw nothing Lat. 12.45. Long 112.04
- Sunday 12. Light airs and calms small swell from S.W. Ships head to the S.E. wind Sun obs.
- Monday 13. Moderate breezes from S.W. and smooth ships head to the N.W. S.W. wind Lat 18.35. Long 110.12.30
- Tuesday 14. Moderate breezes with pleasant weather at 4 P.M. Kept of N.W. for Keelings S.W. down heaved 5. Months out with 170. Bbls. Lat 17.35. Long 108.20
- Wednesday 15. Moderate trades from S.W. compass steered by compass N.W. by im played in fitting and taring rigging Lat 16.27. Long 106.45
- Thursday 16. Moderate breezes from S.E. im played in raising down rigging courses steered N.W. by im Lat 16.16. Long 104.10
- Friday 17. Small breezes from S.E. by E at 3 P.M. Spoke a silted ship bound to Batavia latter part saw blackfish Lat 14.27. S Long 103.45. E
- Saturday 18. Moderate breezes with passing clouds im played in taring down rigging courses steered N.W. Lat 13.05. Long 101.01.15
- Sunday 19. Moderate breezes from S.E. with clear pleasant weather ships head to the N.W. Lat 12.25. Long 99.34.15 E

- Monday Nov. 20th Small breezes from - E ships to the N.W.
- Tuesday 21. Moderate trades from E & S.E. at 1 P.M. Steering N.W. saw coos Isles bearing N.W. dist 5. leagues. at 4 P.M. took a pilot at 5. came to an anchor in five fathoms of water thus ended
- Dec. 11. at 9 A.M. got under way with a small breeze from S.W. at noon coos bearing S.W. dist 10. Miles
- Tuesday 12. Small breezes from S.E. with clear weather ships head to the E. wind. Large swell from S.W. Lat 11.31. S. Small breezes from S.W. ships head to the eastward im played in ships duty clear weather with passing clouds Lat 11.19. S Long 99.14.5
- Wednesday 13. light airs and calms ships head to the S.E. wind winds from S.W. im played in ships duty carpenter in fitting gun carriages thus ended Lat 11.32. S
- Thursday 14. Small breezes of S.W. to E large swell from S. saw nothing all this day im played in repairing keels Lat 11.50. Long 100.30.30. E
- Friday 15. Strong squalls with heavy rain winds from all points Sun obs.
- Saturday 16.
