- Sunday 17. Light baffling winds with heavy squalls of rain at 6 P.M. saw a large sperm whale going S.E. Lat 9.04 S Long 101.30 E
- Monday 18. Light winds with heavy squalls Ship's head to the N.E. toward Small swell from S. Lat 8.42 S Long 102.00
- Tuesday 19. Heavy rains and baffling winds all this day Small swell from S. Lat 8.21 S Long 102.44
- Wednesday 20. Light winds and calms with heavy squalls of rain at 6 A.M. saw 2 ships to the S.W. Small swell from N.W. Lat 7.48
- Thursday 21. Small breezes and calms with heavy squalls of rain at 11 A.M. steering S. by N. saw Java Head bearing N.E. by E. dist 40 miles Small swell from N.W. with a large swell from S
- Friday 22. Small breezes from W. & N.W. at 4 P.M. saw 2 ships to the E. steering S. at noon Java Head bore N by E. dist 40 miles
- Saturday 23. Light airs all this day and calms Ship's head to the S.E. Small swell from S. Lat 8.05 S Long 105.49
- Sunday 24. Throughout this day calm with heavy rain Small swell from S. Lat 8.06 S Long by Gunner 106.16 by Chron. 106.14

Coast of Java Dec. 25th 1837.

- Monday 25. Small breezes N.W. to S.W. land in sight courses steered S by S. Sun at noon this day
- Tuesday 26. Small breezes from W. to S.W. large swell from S.W. land in sight courses steered by compass S by S Lat 8.32 Long 108.49.15
- Wednesday 27. Moderate breezes from W. to S.W. Small swell from S.E. passing clouds with heavy squalls of rain Lat 8.49 Long 111.13
- Thursday 28. Moderate breezes from W. to S.W. with heavy squalls of rain courses steered S by S. land in sight Lat 9.13 S Long 113.00.00 E
- Friday 29. Light breezes and variables with heavy showers of rain at noon last end of Java bore by compass N. dist 35 miles courses steered S by S. Lat 9.23 Long 114.25.58
- Saturday 30. Moderate breezes from W. to S.W. with a large swell from S.W. courses steered S by S. Lat 9.58 S Long 116.20.00 E
- Sunday 31. Small breezes from W. courses steered by compass S by S. Small swell from S.W. strong current setting to the E. Lat 10.15 Long 117.50
- Monday Jan 1. Small breezes all points with heavy thunder and heavy squalls of rain Lat 10.50 118.50 E
- Tuesday 2. Small winds from S.S.E. with clear weather at 6 P.M. saw 3 ships going W. bore 3. dist no more Lat 11.23 Long 118.50
