 and steered out to sea
 Friday 10. Strong trades from E.S.E.
 courses steered by compass. S.
 5. Men sick this day Lat 10.15.
 Saturday 11. Strong trades from E.S.E.
 Ships head to the S.E. Lat 11.30. =
 Sunday 12. Moderate breezes from E.S.E.
 Ships head to the southward
 Clear weather with passing clouds
 Lat 13.34. S 115.20 E
 Monday 13. Strong winds from S.W. heavy
 swell from S.E. Lat 15.16. Long 113.40
 Tuesday 14. Moderate breezes with fine
 weather from S.E. by S at 10 A.M.
 sent in fly gibbons and rigging
 employed in fitting ship for
 the Southern point Lat 16.23. 112.30.10
 Wednesday 15. Moderate breezes from E.S.E.
 Large swell from S.W. ships
 head to the S.W. all drawing
 sail to its advantage
 Lat 17.44. S Long 111.51.00 E

 Thursday 16. Moderate breezes with fine weather
 Ships head to the southward
 at 6 A.M. saw a shoal of large
 whales going N.W. Caught one
 Lat 19.02. Long 111.42. E
 Friday 17. Clear pleasant weather at 3 P.M.
 commence cutting at 6 P.M. cut in the
 body at 5. spoke ship Francis Bennett
 of Newcastle 16 months out with
 1500. Bbls of whale oil & 750 Bbls of sperm
 Lat 19.06. Long 111.34.15 E
 Saturday 18. Moderate breezes from E. 1 P.M.
 commence bailing at 6 P.M. raised
 ship to the N.W. at 6 A.M. raised
 ship to the S.E. all hands employed
 in bailing and cooping Lat 19.18. 111.55
 Sunday 19. Moderate breezes with fine weather
 at 4 A.M. finished bailing
 Ships head to the S.W. Lat 20.20. 111.40
 Monday 20. at 1 P.M. steering S.W. saw a ship
 a head cutting in a sperm whale
 which proved to be Capt Hauke
 at 2 P.M. saw whales lost 3 boats
 caught 3 whales at 4 P.M. came along
 side with the whales at 5.30 P.M.
 saw a shoal of whales lost 3 boats
 caught 3 whales at 11 P.M. came
 along side at 9 A.M. commenced
 cutting this day ends with 7 men down
 with the fore. Lat 20.21. Long 111.35.15
