Tuesday 16th

First part Strong winds from NW
Middle part calm large swell from SW
Latter part light winds from N
Saw 8 whales this day all going W.
Lat 36.06. Long 114.130 E

Wednesday 17th

Moderate breezes from W. and
pleasant weather large swell
from S.W. saw a number of right
whales at 4 P.M. lost 3 Boats struck
one whale killed the whale and
lunk him stove 1 boat Broke 2
oar lost 4. izons and one line
at sun set boats came along side
Latter part saw a number of right
whales going W. Lat 35.49. Long 114.00 E

Thursday 18th

Moderate breezes from SW. Saw
several right whales all going W.
imployed in repairing waste boat
at 4 P.M. got 1 whale. Lat 35.12. Long 115.59.30

Friday 19th

First part Strong winds from NW.
Ship's head S.E. by S middle and
latter part winds from E.S.E. and
fine weather saw quantity of right
whales at 11 A.M. Caught one
imployed in boiling and repairing
Cask Lat 36.35. S. Long 114.50. E.

Saturday 20th

Moderate breezes from E. at 2 P.M.
Boats came along side with the whale
at 3. Commence cutting at 7. finished
middle and latter part a gale from
SW. imployed in boiling Lat 36.45. 114.0248

Coast of New Holland Oct 21st 1838
Sunday 21st

Moderate breezes from E middle
part calm. Latter part heavy
winds from W.S.W. at 8. A.M.
wase ship to the S.E. and reefed the
fore sail. imployed in boiling
Lat 36.18. S. 114.20. E.

Monday 22nd First part Strong winds from W.
3 reefs in main top sail & reefed fore sail
imployed in boiling latter part
moderate saw a number of right
whales going W. imployed in towing
down in the after hatch way
Lat 36.30. Long 114.40. E.

Tuesday 23rd

First part fine weather winds from
W. to S.W. saw a great number of right
whales going west at 3 P.M. caught one
at 4. took up the boats at 5. 4. 16 commence
cutting. Strong winds from W. & rugged
Lat 36.44. S. Long 114.50.00 E.

Wednesday 24th

Strong heavy winds from W. at 4 P.M.
fin. night cutting at 5. commence boiling
at 8. A.M. took in Starboard boat to
repair imployed in boiling and
towing down rigged weather large
swell from S.W. and west Lat 36.42 S

Thursday 25th

gale of wind from W. imployed in
towing down. Lat 36.25. S. Long 114.23. E.

Friday 26th

Strong winds from SW. heavy swell
from S.W. and blue water Lat 35.56
Saturday 27th fine weather winds from
SW. blue water Lat 35.54. Long by chron 114.48.
