

Ship *Lalla Rookh* February 22nd 1839

Friday 22nd

light airs and calm with
heavy squalls of rain large swell
from E. at 6 P.M. calm. Lat 10.41

Saturday 23rd

Bad squally weather at 4 P.M.
saw a shoal of whales going N.W.
caught nothing but observed

Sunday 24th

Strong breezes from E.S.E. at 7 P.M.
saw whales going W.N.W. at 8 A.M.
saw whales going E. lost 4 boats
without aimed Lat 10.46. Long 175.41 W

Monday fine moderate breezes
from E.S.E. saw nothing all this day
Lat 10.44. Long 175.50 W

Tuesday 25th

Moderate breezes from E. with fine
weather Lat 10.48. Long 175.50 W

Wednesday 26th

fine weather small breeze from
W.N.W. Lat 10.44. Long 175.50 W

Thursday 27th

small breezes from W.S.W. at 7 A.M.
saw a shoal of whales going S.E.
lost 4 boats caught 4.
Lat 10.50. Long 175.49 W

Friday 28th

at 1 P.M. commenced cutting
at 5 P.M. finished cutting at 6 A.M.
commenced boiling fine weather
Lat 10.47. Long 175.40 W

Saturday March 1st

impaired in boiling heavy squall
of rain

Sunday 2nd rainy squally weather

Ship *Lalla Rookh* March 3rd 1839

Sunday 3rd

heavy squalls of wind and rain from N.W.
at noon finished boiling at 3 A.M.
wore ship to the S.W. latter part squally
Lat 10.36. Long 173.36.45 W

Monday 4th

squally weather all this day at 5 A.M.
commenced towing down in the fore
hatchway Lat 10.56. Long 173.36.15 W

Tuesday 5th

at 5 P.M. finished towing down
strong breeze with heavy rain
strong current setting to the E.ward
Lat 10.52. Long 173.36.20 W

Wednesday 6th

heavy squalls and thick rainy weather
all this day winds from N.W. to S.W.
Lat at noon 10.46. S

Thursday 7th

strong winds from N.W.
ships head to the westward
Lat 10.50. Long 175.20 W

Friday 8th

Moderate breezes from N with
clear weather large swell from N
at 6 P.M. hove two at 5 A.M.
made sail ships head to the
W.S.W. Lat 11.03. Long 176.20 W

Saturday 9th

throughout this day strong heavy squalls
of wind and rain with ships head
from N.W. to S.W. ships head
to the N.W.ward. Lat 10.28.

Sunday 10th

squally bad weather saw great
quantities of men of war birds
Lat 9.46. Long 174.01. Current 1/4 E
