Thursday

Apr 11th Small breezes and calms all this day ships head to the south small swell from S.E. Lat 5.30. S Long 173.04.45 E

Friday 12th

First part Calm at 4 P.M. small breeze from E.S.E. strong current setting west at 8 A.M. Moderate breeze from E.S.E. ships head to the S.E. clear weather with passing clouds
Lat 6.14. S Long 172.45.30 E

Saturday 13th

Moderate breezes from E.S.E. with light squalls of rain
Lat 6.53. S 172.44.30 E

Sunday 14th

Moderate breezes from E.S.E. all this day ships head to the S.E. and S.W. saw nothing
Lat 8.22. S 173.2.30 E

Monday 15th

Moderate breezes with squally weather winds from E. large swell from S.E. Lat 9.13. S

Tuesday 16th

Moderate winds from E. with strong squalls of rain and wind Lat 10.10. S Long 173.25.30 E

Wednesday 17th

Light winds and variables with hard squalls of wind from E. by N. to E. by S. Lat 11.57. S Long 173.35 E

Thursday 18th

light breeze and variable

light breeze and calms all this day with a smother sea winds from E.S.E. to E.N.E. Lat 13.33. S Long 173.44.15 E

Saturday 20th

Small breezes and calms all this day and smother all possible sail carried to get to the East Lat 13.24.17 E

Sunday 21st

Small winds from S.E. and smother with clear weather Lat 13.06. Long 174

Monday 22nd

Moderate breezes from N.W. and fine

Tuesday 23rd

quick breezes from N.W. at 3 P.M. saw the Island of Rotuma bearing E. by N. distance 12 leagues

May 7th

at 1 P.M. after refasting the crew and getting wood and water and yams left the Rotumah for the Fijes with a light wind from E.S.E.

Friday 10. Small winds from E.S.E. ships head to the S.W. ward

Sunday 11.

Strong winds from E. 2 Reefs in the top sails

Monday 12th

Strong winds from E. 2 Reefs in the top sails at 6 A.M. wase ship
Lat 15.30. S Long 176.40

Tuesday 13th Strong winds from E. by S. large swell from N.E. clear weather with falling clouds
