Moderate breezes from S.W. with
fine weather large swell from S.W.
Cora bearing N.W. dist 20 miles

Thursday 13th

Commences with moderate breezes
from N.W. and pleasant weather
at 5 P.M. wore ship to the S.E. large
swell from N.W. at 1 A.M. wore
ship to the N.W. pleasant weather
with passing clouds at noon
Cora bearing N.W. dist 5 leagues

Friday 14th

First part Moderate breezes from S.E.
Ship head to the west at P.M.
took in top gallant sails and main
sail large swell from S.W. all
appearance of a gale of wind at 6 A.M.
winds from E.N.E. with thick rainy
weather made all sail ships
head to the N.W. Sun obscured

Saturday 15th

First part Moderate breezes from
N.E. Ship head to the N.W.
Middle part Calm latter part
strong winds from S.E. and
rainy Ship head to the S.W.
Sunday 16th

Strong winds from S.E. Ship head
to the S.W. by W. at 10 A.M. Cora
bore of compass E dist 7 leagues

Monday

Strong heavy winds from E.S.E.
at 1 A.M. wore ship to the S.E.
at noon Pleasant bore N.W.
dist 15 miles Lat 22.36

Tuesday 18th

Strong heavy wind from E.
Ship head to the south at 5 P.M.
Close reefed main top sail and set
Main stay sail sent down sprinker
and bent the mizen at 8 A.M.
run bent and bent a main top sail
Strong winds and rugged

Wednesday 19th

Moderate breezes from E. with fine
weather at noon Spoke Ship Scianor
of Portland 10. Moots out with 500 whale
oil and 50. Sperm same day Spoke
Ship Rambler of Nantucket 6. men
20. bls. sperm oil Lat 24.27. 176.00

Thursday 20th

quick breezes from N.E. Ship head
to the south west at 1 A.M. wore
ship to the S.W. and sail in sight
to the East Lat 26.31

Friday 21st

Strong heavy winds from S. at 5 P.M.
hoisted two under close reefed main top sail
and stay sails Ship head to the E.S.E.
at mid night wore ship to the E.
heavy swell from S. Clear weather
with passing clouds Lat 28.36

Saturday 22nd

Strong winds from S.E. at 10 A.M. saw
a large whale going S.E. chased 2. with
out success at 11 saw 2. Ship to the
E. steering N.W. Lat 24.17. 175.50

Sunday 23rd

at 5 P.M. Spoke Bark Stateman of Salem
Coffin master. 8 months out 250 bls. Sperm
