

Ship Lalla Pookh July 7th 1839

Sunday 7th

Friday First part calm middle part moderate breezes from S.E. ships head to the N.W. latter part heavy winds from S.E. by S. 2. reef in the top sails at noon. hove two ships head to the east Lat 23.58. S. thus ends

Saturday 8th

Strong heavy winds from S.E. by S at 7. A.M. set the fore sail and fore top sail large sea from south west clear weather with passing clouds Lat 23.27. Long 171.07

Sunday 9th

Commences with moderate breezes from S.E. with fine weather at 6. P.M. hove to ships head to the N.E. latter part strong heavy winds from E. Ship laying under close reef main top sail Lat 23.25 S

Monday 10th

Moderate breezes with fine weather at 6. A.M. made all sail light breeze from E.N.E. ships head to the north west employed in cleaning ship Lat 23.11. 170.10

Tuesday 11th

Moderate breezes with fine weather small breezes from N.W. at 7. A.M. commenced painting ship Lat 22.44. S

Wednesday 12th

Clear weather and light winds from E by N. ships head to the N by W large swell from S. employed in painting ship all this day Lat 21.25

Thursday 13th

Moderate breezes from N. with fine weather at 6. P.M. finished painting ships head to the west Lat 22.25. S

Ship Lalla Pookh July 14th 1839

Sunday 14th

Moderate breezes from N. ships head to the W. at 6. P.M. hove to at 6. A.M. made sail at 10. A.M. wose ship to the N.W. winds from W thick and rainy thus ends this day

Monday 15th

First part calm latter part strong winds from S.E. at 6. A.M. wose ship to the N.W. and made all sail large swell from S. Lat 21.34. S

Tuesday 16th

heavy gale of wind from S.E. all this day Lat 20.40 S

Wednesday 17th

heavy gale from S.E. laying to under close reef main top sail and fore sail and stay sails Lat 20.17. S

Thursday 18th

through out this day thick heavy rain storm strong winds from E.S.E. at 10. P.M. wose ship to the S.E. wose sun obscured all this day

Friday 19th

through out this day a heavy gale of wind from E.S.E. with a heavy sea and heavy rain at 11. A.M. moderate with passing clouds Lat 19.49. 172.04.45

Saturday 20th

Strong gale of wind all this day ships head to the N.E. winds from S.E. by E. Lat at noon 18.54. 172.08.20

Sunday 21st

First part a gale of wind from E.S.E. middle and latter part moderate at 6. A.M. set close reef top sails and fore sail Lat 18.57. Long 172.04.30.20
