several whales at 8 A.M. saw two
large swell from S.W. in played in
boiling and setting up shocks.
Lat 32.40. Long 167.47 W.

Friday 25th

a gale of wind from W. S.W. in played
in cleaning bone Lat 32.44. Long 167.43

Saturday 26th

Strong winds from W. S.W. large
swell from S.W. latter part in played
in blowing down Lat 32.44. Long 167.33

Sunday 27th

Strong winds from W. large swell from
N.W. ships head to the S.W. clear weather
with passing clouds. Lat 33.05. Long 167.54. W.

Monday 28th

Strong winds from S.W. ships head to
the N.W. at 8 A.M. saw one whale
at 10. struck and killed him Lat 32.43. Long 167.42

Tuesday 29th

Moderate breezes from N.W. at 3 P.M.
commenced cutting at 6. fin night
at 9 A.M. saw one whale going
S.W. large swell from S.W. Lat 32.23. Long 167.17

Wednesday 30th

Moderate breezes from W. at 5 P.M.
saw whales at 6 A.M. saw whales
caught one Lat 32.23. Long 167.17 W.

Saturday 2^d

at 6 P.M. fin night cutting middle part
saw latter part fine weather at 6 A.M.
saw whales Lat 32.39. Long 167.49 W.

Sunday 3^d

Moderate breezes from west was at 4
P.M. caught one whale and cut him
in latter part squally in played in
boiling and blowing down. Sun obscured

Monday 4th

Strong heavy winds from W. S.W. to S.E.
in played in boiling and blowing down
saw no whales this day. Sun obscured

Tuesday 5th

Fore part strong winds from S.W.
at 2 A.M. fin night boiling latter
part in played in blowing down
Lat 32.29. Long 168.24 W.

Wednesday 6th

fine smooth weather at 7 P.M. spoke
bark isabella of fair haven 22 months
500. Sperm oil 4200. (W. at 5 A.M.)
saw whales loaded in company with
the bark boats the bark boats got
the wall at 8 A.M. saw more
