fine smooth weather at 5 P.M. saw whales
 killed and sunk one at 5. A.M. saw 4
 whales struck two and saved one the
 other boat parted the line and lost
 the whale sun obscured

Friday 8th

Strong heavy winds from E. & S. with
 thick weather in play in boiling
 at 10. A.M. saw one whale but shy
 Lat 33.04.

Strong winds from N. with thickening
 weather sun obscured

 foggy in play in towing down

Moderate breezes with fine pleasant
 weather in play in boiling at 5 A.M.
 saw whales caught 2 remainder

 with 500 lbs of sperm oil and 400 of
 whale oil supplied her with cassand
 lines & took in exchange 100 lbs of bread
 Lat 33.07. Long 168.12. W

Tuesday 19th fine weather in play
 in cooping & towing down at 10. A.M.
 saw whales going. Lat 33.19. Long 168.34
