Tuesday 24th

Commences with Moderate breezes from E.
and makes 5 sail in sight - Steering to the
N.E. ward at 7 P.M. thick and snowing
at 10 P.M. thick and rainy have to get
ground in 30 fathoms wore ship to the
S.E. wind in creasing all appearance of
a gale of winds from E. at mid night
heavy winds from E put 3 reefs in
the top sails took in the gill and main
Course and Spanker heavy Sea from S.E.
at 6 A.M. have to at 7 set close reefs top sails
wore ship to the N.E. at 10 A.M. got ground
in 33 fathoms wore ship to the S.E. heavy
from E by N thick rainy cold weather
Sun obscured Lat by account ~~37~~ 37. 37 Long 73. 30
Wednesday 25th

Strong gale of wind from E by N at 6 P.M.
Calm at 7 P.M. strong wind from N.W. at 8
gale from N.W. ship's head to the East
ward at 9 A.M. wore ship to the S.W. at 11 A.M.
saw a Brig to the wind ward steering N.W.
Sun obscured Lat by act.

Thursday 26th (1840)
Throughout this day a gale of wind from N.W.
at 10 A.M. set close reefs main top sail and
reefs fore sail ship's head to the N.E. ward
from 8 A.M. until noon past 3 Brigs
laying to thus ends Lat 37. 19
