This 24 hours commences with calm weather men
employed mending sail at 3 PM took 8 light
breezes from the S.E. Gorse took in sail at dark
mile & later part light rain's main all sail at day
light and stand W.W. 41 and 50 ends this 24
hours Lat 14 00

Remarks on Board Monday March 22 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate rain's from the
S.E. Gorse W.W. took in sail at dark mile & later part
moderate rain's, bled all hands at day light main all sail
and 50 ends this 24 hours Lat 12 37 5

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 23 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate rain's
from the S.E. Gorse W.W. men employed at ships
day mile & later part strong rain's and with good weather
Lat

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 24 1841
This 24 hours commences with brisk rain's from the
S.E. Gorse W.W. at 5 PM saw black fish low and saw
two hawks there in air took in sail and hauled to the
Southward & Westward main sail at day light and stand
ends with good weather men employed men employed
mending blubber Lat

Remarks on Board Thursday March 25 1841
This 24 hours commences with strong rain's from
the S.E. Gorse West at 3 PM started the works at 10 finished
baking blackfish Calipall hands at day light and stand
West ends with strong rain's and good weather a few
repair sail and mended stitches and so ends this 24
hours saw blackfish Lat 12 03 5

Remarks on Board Friday March 26 1841
This 24 hours commences with strong rain's from the
S.E. Gorse West. Bled the rigging sail and took in sail at
dark and hauled to the Southward & Westward bled all hands at
day light main sail was raised and hauled in shore ends with
strong rain's and seen rain no observation
Lat

Remarks on Board Saturday March 27 1841
This 24 hours commences with strong rain's from the
S.E. heaving S.W. & blowing wither and seen rain to 10
in sail at dark saw porpoises mile & later part moderate
rain's and plenty of rain broke out and filled up a cask of
water in the black room and so ends this 24 hours
Lat 10 36 5

Remarks on Board Sunday March 28 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate rain's from the S.E.
and plenty of rain heaving S.W. took in sail at sunset
mile & later part moderate rain's saw plenty of blackfish
and fine weather Lat 9 38 5

Remarks on Board Monday March 29 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate rain's & fine
with saw plenty of black fish took in sail at sunset
and heaving in shore mile & later part moderate rain's
saw black fish & finbacks men employed at ships day and
50 ends this 24 hours Lat 8 11 5

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 30 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate rain's from the
S.E. saw blackfish & finbacks main & fore top yabunt
crossed and put it on set up the rigging and took in
sail at dark mile & later part moderate rain's men employed
at this day and so ends this 24 hours
Lat 7 38 5

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 31 1841
This 24 hours begins with moderate rain's & fine with
heaving to the Northward took in sail at sunset were and
unhauled in to the Southward & Westward bled all hands at day
light main all sail and heaving in shore at 11 saw black fish
ends with fine weather

Remarks on Board April 1 1841
This 24 hours begins with light rain's and good weather
at 3 PM saw John's island's hauled ship at 4 PM and heaving
shore men employed at ships day mile & later part moderate
rain's ends with good weather saw 2 sail at 8 distance
