

Remarks on Board Wednesday April ^{the} 14 1841

This 24 hours begins with moderate winds SSW all hands employed beating in rigails but then in finished at 5 PM set and started the work middle & later part light winds and good weather clear & saw the heads and Boiling oil saw a sail at a distance and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Thursday April ^{the} 15 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds from the NW all hands employed Boiling oil finished Boiling Boiling at 10 PM and commences on the head saw Boiling middle & later part light winds all hands employed Boiling oil and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday April ^{the} 16 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds from the SSW saw one ship Boiling at a distance finished Boiling at 6 PM and filled up the pots with fat clean Bilt & fire wood let them stay until morning middle & later part light winds and good weather spoke the ship James Monroe of fair haven Capt. Cushman with 200 bbls oil and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Saturday April ^{the} 17 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the South blow in to the land Capt went to shore with Capt Cushman by of and on there the bright middle & later part winds from all parts of the compass and plenty of rain thunder & lightning Boat came of at 10 PM and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Sunday April ^{the} 18 1841

This 24 hours commences with winds from all parts of the compass at 1 PM Capt went to shore at 7 PM sent in one Boat later part calm and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Monday April ^{the} 19 1841

This twenty four hours commences with moderate winds from all parts of the compass blowing on at a distance at 6 PM Boat came of took in sail and head of shore middle & later part seen Calm and plenty of rain spoke the ship James Monroe Capt Cushman and so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday April ^{the} 20 1841

This 24 hours commences with Boiling winds from all parts of the compass in company with one ship and a breeze for winds took in sail at dark and plenty of rain middle & later part light winds from all parts of the compass saw one sail at a distance

Lat 02 = 14 N

Remarks on Board Wednesday April ^{the} 21 1841

This 24 hours commences with calm weather at 3 PM took a light breeze from the SW took in a sail at dark middle part calm later part light winds from the SW saw a frigate saw the land distance distance 6 leagues and so ends this 24 hours

Lat 2 = 55 N

Remarks on Board Thursday April ^{the} 22 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds from the SW saw the island of Gorgona run for it till 3 PM then breast of anchor on the wind of shore took in sail at dark middle & later part calm weather saw grasshoppers and so ends this 24 hours

Lat 03 = 18 N

Remarks on Board Friday April ^{the} 23 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds from all round the compass saw a ship at anchor under the land took in sail at dark and head of shore middle & later part light rain & bells and sundown and so ends this 24 hours

Observation

Remarks on Board Saturday April ^{the} 24 1841

This 24 hours commences with moderate winds from all round the compass and plenty of rain took in sail at dark middle & later part the same saw one barres and Porpoises and so ends this 24 hours

Lat 03 = 20 N

Remarks on Board Sunday April ^{the} 25 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds distant and good weather saw porpoises & grasshoppers the island of Gorgona Baring South distance 6 leagues saw the main land took in sail at dark middle & later part moderate winds and so ends this 24 hours

Lat 3 = 44 N
