This 24 hours commences with moderate winds and good weather being of shore took in sail at dusk and later part calm saw plenty of small fish but one turtle all hands employed stowing down oil and getting out water and so on's this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 27 1841
This 24 hours commences with light variable winds one Breach took in sail at dusk and later part light variable & squally and so on's this 24 hours
No observation

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 28 1841
This 24 hours commences with light variable winds from all parts of the compass took in sail at dusk and later part light variable Breach took in sail at dusk and later part light variable and so on's this 24 hours
No observation

Remarks on Board Thursday April 29 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.W. being to the southward & eastward took in sail at dusk and later part light variable & squally and so on's this 24 hours
No observation

Remarks on Board Friday April 30 1841
This 24 hours commences with moderate winds from all round the compass took in sail at dusk and later part moderate winds & good weather one sail in sight saw porpoises & billers and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 12'

Remarks on Board Saturday May 1 1841
This 24 hours commences with light winds from the N.W. cruising for wharves landed all sail at daylight for to hold on bearing Steady to the N.E. and later part light variable and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 12'

Remarks on Board Sunday May 2 1841

This 24 hours commences with light winds from all round the compass & cruising for wharves saw one sail at a distance from 2 till 10 miles at 10 took a light wind from the southward middle & later part the same saw plenty of black fish in billers and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 26'

Remarks on Board Monday May 3 1841
This 24 hours commences with calm weather saw one sail at a distance at 6 PM took a light breeze from the N.W. middle part calm later part light winds from the southward men employed at this today and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 24'

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 4 1841
This 24 hours commences with light breeze from the N.W. saw one sail at a distance from 3 till 10 miles & later part light winds & plenty of rain saw one sail at a distance and so on's this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 5 1841
This 24 hours commences with light breeze from all parts of the compass and plenty of rain middle & later part light breeze and plenty of rain saw one sail at a distance and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 13'

Remarks on Board Thursday May 6 1841
This 24 hours commences with light breeze from the S.W. from 1 till 4 miles had the N.E. & W. tacked ship and heaving to at 5 took in top galls and sails and blowing wither saw one sail at a distance middle & later part light breeze men employed at ships duty and so on's this 24 hours
Lat 35 13'

Remarks on Board Friday May 7 1841
This 24 hours begins with moderate winds from the N.W. at 4 PM took ship heaving to 3 till 6 miles & later part moderate winds and good weather broke out and before the breeze and so on's this 24 hours
