 this 24 hours commences with light winds from the N.E. being South men in place, Coopering Breach milled & later part moderate winds from the N.E. saw grasshoppers and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 3:30 AM

Remarks on Board Sunday May 5th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with light winds from the N.E. mile part raining later part moderate winds from the N.E. and good weather and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 2:30 AM

Remarks on Board Monday May 6th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the N.E. spoke the ship Public of Nantucket Capt Gardner 21 men's cut 1300 lbs of sperm oil reported had spoke the ship Robinson Capt W. H. 9 men's cut 600 lbs of sperm oil mile & later part light winds from the S.W. and sun rain at 10 AM and boat and under the current and found that it little sitting 6 AM and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 1:50 AM

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 7th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with light winds from the S.W. saw one sail at a distance saw hump backs & porpoises at sun set thick weather and sun rain mile & later moderate winds from the S.W. and good weather and so on this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 8th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with brisk breezes from the S.W. saw one sail at a distance saw fin backs mile & later part brisk breezes and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 1:09 AM

Remarks on Board Thursday May 9th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with the Brisk Breezes from the S.W. stood in within 10 miles of the land and hauled ashore at 2 PM saw humpers at 5 took in main top galant sail and kept the main top sail and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 1:30 AM

Remarks on Board Friday May 10th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with Brisk Breezes from the S.W. being in shore saw hump backs and one sail at 6 PM hauled of shore took in main top galant sail mile & later part moderate winds from the S.W. saw one sail and fin backs and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 1:11 AM

Remarks on Board Saturday May 11th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.W. cruising for whails of Point galley saw one sail saw grasshoppers and fin backs at sun set saw Baring from 8 to 8 1/2 distance 6 leagues mile & later part moderate winds from the S.W. saw fin backs & hump backs and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 00:28 AM

Remarks on Board Sunday May 12th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with Brisk Breezes from the S.W. being of shore saw fin backs and one sail took in fly jib & raised top galant sail at dark mile & later part light winds at 7 PM raised whails at 11 AM & struck line over fore and aft for to cut whails started and we went to fore and aft there with the ship whails at 11 AM & saw distance 2 miles and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 00:40 AM By it boat
 Sat 41:20 AM

Remarks on Board Monday May 13th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.W. Chasing whail at 1 PM fore struck fore and said one took him & long side & put him over set greater whails hooked ship at 1 PM and stood of shore mile & later part moderate winds and good weather saw porpoises but all hands at day light but up the head and started the whails and so on this 24 hours
 Sat 00:33 AM

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 14th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with moderate winds from the S.W. all hands employed Baring oil took in top galant sails at dark saw one sail at a distance mile & later part strong breezes and blowing wither finished Baring at 3 PM saw fin backs and so on this 24 hours & observation

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 15th 1841
 this 24 hours commences with strong breezes from the S.W. cruising for whails of Point galley mile & later part Brisk Breezes at 4 PM raised whails and saw fin backs and so on this 24 hours
