 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ making spungum picking oar and other
 work double reef the top sails at dark middle & later
 part midair trade saw hump Backs & Blackfish
 men employ at ships entry and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 4:47.5

Remarks on Board Sunday June 13 1841
 The 24 hours commences with midair trade from the
 SE saw Blackfish & Porpoises took in fore & main
 sails at dark had up 55 sp. mile & later part Brisk
 breezes and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 5:53.5

Remarks on Board Monday June 14 1841
 The 24 hours commences with strong trade from the
 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ making spungum broke out the sail room
 and took at the sails and the mice had eat some of them
 and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 5:16.5

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 15 1841
 The 24 hours commences with Brisk trade from the
 SE having SE W men employ picking oar and
 other work mile & later part strong trade men employ
 making spungum and other work and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 4:55.5

Remarks on Board Wednesday June 16 1841
 The 24 hours commences with strong trade from the
 SE having SE W saw plenty of Blackfish & hump Backs
 double reef the top sails took in fore & main sail at dark
 were ship and had SE W mile & later part strong trade
 saw the land at a horn and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 4:22.5

Remarks on Board Thursday June 17 1841
 The 24 hours commences with strong trade from the
 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ at ships entry took in fore & main
 top & main sails at dark mile & later part light trade
 and foggy weather saw hump Backs & Blackfish broke
 out and fell up 5 cask of water and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 5:06.5

 The 24 hours commences with midair trade from the
 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ making spungum picking oar and other
 work double reef the top sails at dark middle & later part
 midair trade men employ making spungum and other
 work and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 5:19.5

Remarks on Board Saturday June 19 1841
 The 24 hours commences with midair trade from the
 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ making spungum broke out the sail room
 and took at the sails and the mice had eat some of them
 and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 5:43.5

 The 24 hours commences with light trade from the
 SE having SE W saw hump Backs & Blackfish men
 employ making spungum broke out the sail room
 and took at the sails and the mice had eat some of them
 and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 6:03.5

Remarks on Board Monday June 21 1841
 The 24 hours commences with light trade from the SE
 at 1 Pm saw Blackfish men but did not see saw the
 land the trade of shore at 6 Pm mile & later part light trade
 saw Blackfish men and saw a 6 took them at long side
 and hoisted them in and so ends this 24 hours
 No observation

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 22 1841
 The 24 hours commences with light trade from the
 SE all hands employ clearing & drying Blackfish
 started the rigging at 4 Pm mile & later part
 light trade finished Boiling at 1 Pm and so ends this 24
 hours
 Sat 6:40.5

Remarks on Board Wednesday June 23 1841
 The 24 hours commences with light trade from the
 SE men employ at ships entry took in fore & main
 top & main sails at dark mile & later part light trade
 and foggy weather saw hump Backs & Blackfish broke
 out and fell up 5 cask of water and so ends this 24 hours
 Sat 6:46.5
