

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 6th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE all hands employed Boiling oil took in sail at dark more room at 12 and hauled 8th mile & later part strong trade at 10 & raised breeches on the water beam men employed Boiling out fat lean and so ends the 24 hours

 Remarks on Board Wednesday July 7th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE saw breeches at 1 came up with the wind 3 low but did not raise fore in sail at dark mile & later part strong trade saw fish backs and so ends the 24 hours Sat 15:24 S

Remarks on Board Thursday July 8th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE left at 12 and steamed to the Western side in sail at dark hauled the wire to the boat wire mile & later part strong trade saw fish backs and so ends the 24 hours Sat 16:15 S

Remarks on Board Friday July 9th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE men employed at ship's victuals all hands at day night were ship and went to strong iron oil mile & later part brisk breeze all hands employed strong iron oil and so ends the 24 hours Sat 5:36 S

Remarks on Board Saturday July 10th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with brisk trade from the SE saw hump backs all hands employed strong iron oil mile & later part moderate trade all hands employed strong iron oil finished at 11 got iron and so ends the 24 hours Sat 5:00 S

Remarks on Board Sunday July 11th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with moderate trade from the SE all hands employed mending ship took in sail at dark mile part moderate trade raised rigging at 10 & got iron wire at 11 and ends with moderate wind and chasing wharls No observation Sat

Remarks on Board Monday July 12th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with moderate trade from the SE employed Chasing wharls. But did not raise hoisted up our boats and chased them with the ship took in sail at dark wharls on the water beam at dark distance 2 miles mile & later part moderate wind saw our ship at distance and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:21 S Long 45:42 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 13th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with moderate trade from the SE copper employed repairing back raised rigging at 12 low at 1 o'clock 2 men and file 2 took them & long side got ready for fat iron mile part strong trade all hands at day night and but in over wharls finished at 9 o'clock commenced with the head and main sail saw Blackfish and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:06 S Long 45:10 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 14th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with moderate trade from the SE having 55th all hands employed Chasing & mending finished at 12 PM washed of decks and commenced Boiling beam at 3 PM saw breeches at 6 PM miles & mile & later part strong trade all hands employed Boiling oil and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:02

Remarks on Board Thursday July 15th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE having 55th all hands employed Boiling oil mile & later part strong trade finished Boiling at 3 o'clock at night and commenced at fat lean men employed at ship's victuals copper repairing back and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:16 S

Remarks on Board Friday July 16th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with strong trade from the SE took in ship at 1 PM and having 55th took in top gale and sails at dark mile & later part strong trade copper employed repairing back carpenter employed repairing try works and men at ship's victuals and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:43 S

Remarks on Board Saturday July 17th 1841
 The 24 hours commenced with brisk trade from the SE took in ship at 1 PM saw breeches to the mainmast took in sail at dark more room at 12 mile & later part strong trade all hands employed strong iron oil saw Blackfish and so ends the 24 hours Sat 4:54 S
