

Remarks onboard Friday July 30th 1941
the 24 hours brisk breezes all hands employed
getting water & going it down mile & later part
morning breezes are good with all hands employed getting
water and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks onboard Saturday July 31st 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW all hands
employed working at 4 PM took in & raft and left with
water and gave the men liberty the rest of the day

Remarks onboard Sunday August 1st 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW all hands
employed working at 4 PM took in & raft and left with
water and gave the men liberty the rest of the day

Remarks onboard Monday August 2nd 1941
the 24 hours morrait breezes were on liberty at 5
sent all hands to sea with at 11 AM boat returned after dinner
and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks onboard Tuesday August 3rd 1941
the 24 hours morrait breezes blowing with and some
rain sent 2 boats for water Boat of 5 men at 6 AM
sent 2 boats working on boat of 2 men and sent
with good weather boats returned from working and
sent them after water returned at 5 PM in the water

Remarks onboard Wednesday August 4th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind with rain with
2 boats off & raft of water are fetching & spate
at 6 PM boats returned with the water Boat of 2 men of spate
bale all hands are sent to stow down water & rig at
10 AM took the anchor and sent to sea all hands employed
storing anchors & 60

Remarks onboard Thursday August 5th 1941
the 24 hours strong breezes from SSW all hands employed
cleaning the deck storing cables and other work mile & later
part morrait wind and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks onboard Friday August 6th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from SSW took in
ship at 4 PM and left SSW mile & later part morrait
wind and employed at ship duty
Lat 1:50 N

Remarks onboard Saturday August 7th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW
at 1 PM sent the land distance 10 leagues took in ship at
6 AM and left SSW mile & later part morrait wind
employed taking fore rigging fore down back stays and stabs
side of the fore rigging and so ends the 24 hours
Lat 00 = 34 N

Remarks onboard Sunday August 8th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from SSW being SSW
men employed at ship duty took in ship at 6 PM and left
SSW mile & later part morrait wind took in ship at 7
AM and being SSW and so ends the 24 hours
Lat 00 = 14 S

Remarks onboard Monday August 9th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW sent
the land at 12 took in at 4 PM the ship President of
Kauai set Capt. Standish 33 men out 1350 lbs of
mule & later part morrait wind and good weather let the ship
President have back of breeze and men employed taking
rigging 13 observation

Remarks onboard Tuesday August 10th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW being
W took in ship at 7 AM and being SSW men employed at ship duty
mile & later part morrait wind men employed taking down
rigging
Lat 00 = 24 S

Remarks onboard Wednesday August 11th 1941
the 24 hours morrait wind from the SSW sent the
land at 12 took in at 6 PM and being W mile & later part
morrait breezes and good weather and so ends the 24 hours
Lat 1:50 S
