Remarks on board Thursday August 26th 1841
The 24 hours employ painting and other work one
water on liberty & shore broke out and fell up
20 bbls of oil and landed it

Remarks on board Friday August 27th 1841
The 24 hours migrant train all hands employ painting
ship and the water filled painting and so ends the 24
hours

Remarks on board Saturday August 28th 1841
The 24 hours give water sent one water on shore
on liberty and the other employe Boating & Potatoes
& Curers and their work

Remarks on board Sunday August 29th 1841
The 24 hours give water one water on liberty
and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks on board Monday August 30th 1841
The 24 hours strong train all hands on board getting ready
for sea and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks on board Tuesday August 31st 1841
The 24 hours migrant train from S.C. all hands on board
stove the Stabon anchor and got ready for sea and so
ends the 24 hours

Remarks on board Wednesday September 1st 1841
The 24 hours comes with brisk train from the S.C.
at 2 o'clock our anchor and went to sea got the anchors
on the boat's course N.W. 1/4 W. at 2 o'clock of N.W. 1/4
at daylight saw 2 sail and with strong train
Got 3:20 S

Remarks on board Thursday September 2nd 1841
The 24 hours comes with brisk train from the S.C.
steering N.W. at 1 o'clock of S.C. saw the land at 5 P.M.
tacked of shore at 7 o'clock in at 2 o'clock at daylight saw the
land distance 5 leagues off of N.W. end with light train
saw one sail Got 3:55 S

Remarks on board Friday September 3rd 1841
The 24 hours comes with light train from the S.C.
steering a long iron shore for torches at sunset bali
on the iron of shore took in top galant sails more over at 12
and bali in shore saw the land at daylight and end with
light train steering for torches Got

Remarks on board Saturday September 4th 1841
The 24 hours comes with light train from the
S.C. steering a long iron shore for torches at 5 P.M.
came to anchor at torches where there was 13 sail of
resets from the sails and lay with 40 fathoms of Shave
but all hands at daylight washed and am sent 1 boat after
Potatoes returned at 10 o'clock and sent 2 boats after
water and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks on board Sunday September 5th 1841
The 24 hours comes with migrant train from the
S.C. all hands employ getting water & Potatoes end with
migrant train and good weather

Remarks on board Monday September 6th 1841
The 24 hours comes with migrant train from
the S.C. sent boats after Potatoes returned at 10 o'clock the
Stabon anchor and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks on board Tuesday September 7th 1841
The 24 hours comes with give water sent in 2
boats for Potatoes returned with out then sent them
in & gain in the morning returned at 9 with them
at 10 o'clock our anchor and went to sea in company
with the ship George of fair haul Got 9:20 S
