

Remarks onboard Wednesday December 24th 1741

The sea was calm with light winds from the SE to SW with blowing neither saw black fish spoke the ship Sylvia of Newcastle Capt. Cook's boat 15 masts out 45 bls of oil middle & later part brisk breeze and plenty of rain saw several sail at a distance No observation

Remarks onboard Thursday December 25th 1741

The sea was calm with moderate winds from the SW crossing of Duibo with blowing with plenty of rain spoke the ship Spirit of New Bedford took in sail at dusk saw the land bearing a distance 6 leagues middle & later part plenty of rain

Remarks onboard Friday December 26th 1741

All the day was blowing with plenty of rain winds all round the compass No observation

Remarks onboard Saturday December 27th 1741

The sea was calm with light winds from the SW crossing of Duibo saw several sail spoke the ship of Newcastle Capt. Cook's boat took in top galvant sails at dusk middle part rainy later part gave wither saw plenty of drift wood

Remarks onboard Sunday December 28th 1741

The sea was calm with calm neither saw the island of Duibo bearing a distance 10 leagues saw 3 sail at a distance took in top galvant sails at dusk about the fore top galvant sail and mizen at mid beat at dusk middle part rainy later part calm and clear wither

Remarks onboard Monday December 29th 1741

The sea was calm with calm neither saw black fish were but could not catch him spoke the ship John of 100 and ship Braunt of 50 ship Sylvia of Newcastle saw the ship Margaret Capt. of New Bedford at a distance at sunset the land bearing a distance 10 leagues middle part plenty of rain with gave wither men employ'd at ship's duty

Remarks onboard Tuesday December 30th 1741

The sea was calm with calm neither saw plenty of old logs were and took one for new saw black fish were but did not fish saw Duibo bearing a distance 13 leagues saw 4 sail at a distance middle & later part moderate winds from the SW and gave wither saw plenty of porpoises took in ship at 10 o'clock of shore Duibo bearing a distance 3 leagues

Remarks onboard Wednesday December 1st 1741

The sea was calm with light winds from the SW crossing of Duibo saw several sail at a distance took in top galvant sails at dusk the Island of Duibo bearing a distance 4 leagues middle & later part moderate winds men employ'd mending sails

Remarks onboard Thursday December 2nd 1741

The sea was calm with light winds from the SW and gave wither crossing of Duibo saw in a boat at 6 O'clock and got a load of coconuts returned at dusk with 200 saw a man on shore that was foot hair by the ship Margaret got drunk & later part moderate winds on beat the main top sail and sent another one and comest mending the deau and so ends the 24 hours

Remarks onboard Friday December 3rd 1741

The sea was calm with moderate winds from the West crossing of Duibo men employ'd mending sails Duibo bearing a distance 10 leagues took in top sails at dusk middle & later part moderate winds with sun rain

Remarks onboard Saturday December 4th 1741

The sea was calm with moderate winds bearing in shore on beat the main top sail and sent another one double reef at dusk and beat of shore middle & later part moderate winds and plenty of rain saw 4 sail at 10 O'clock lighted up top of for the deau

Remarks onboard Sunday December 5th 1741

The sea was calm with light winds from the SW to a north east took in top sails at dusk Duibo bearing a distance 4 leagues with plenty of rain thore the night middle part plenty of rain sent a boat to shore at 9 O'clock after coconuts gave the man before mentioned sun break & meat & clothing & provisions &c.

Remarks onboard Monday December 6th 1741

The sea was calm with moderate winds from the SW and plenty of rain saw 1 sail at a distance middle part plenty of rain later part calm saw porpoises took in the fore boat & mizen at men employ'd at ship's duty

Remarks onboard Tuesday December 7th 1741

The sea was calm with calm with calm neither crossing of Duibo bearing a distance 6 leagues middle & later part calm saw porpoises and 5 sail at a distance
